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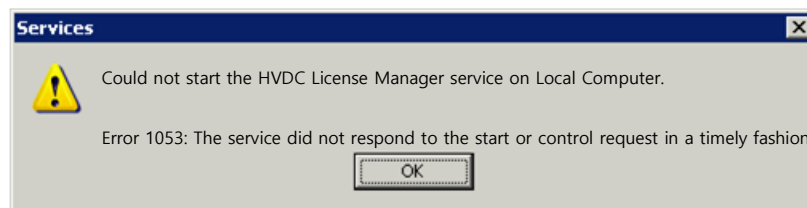
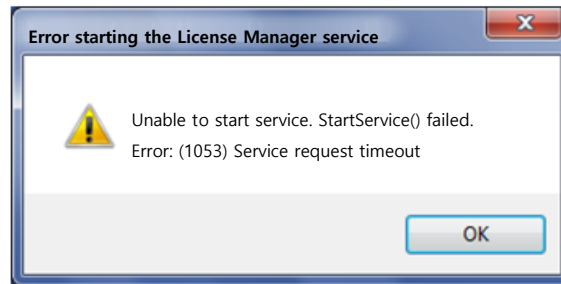
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1. Installation Error – Error 1053 Starting LM Service

Situation

When installing the License Manager onto a machine, the installer displays a message similar to one of the following:



Known Incidences

- License Manager 1.31

Causes

- Your machine is missing one or more required Microsoft prerequisites.

Solution 1: Install Prerequisites before License Manager

- a. Download and install the Microsoft .NET 4.0 Framework Full.
- b. Download and install the Microsoft Visual C++ Redistributables 2010 (x86)
- c. Re-launch the License Manager installer

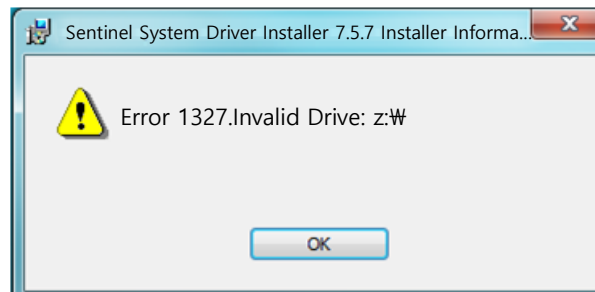
Solution 2: Upgrade the License Manager to 1.33

- a. Install License Manager 1.33 (or better).

2. Installation Error – Error 1327 - Invalid Drive

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD or the License Manager, the installer displays a message similar to the following:



Causes

- A Sentinel installer issue,
- A Windows issue with a previously remapped drive,
- A registry issue, or
- An unknown issue.

Solution 1: Install Latest Drivers

- a. Download and install the latest Sentinel drivers from here:

http://updater.pscad.com/utilities/USBDrivers_7.5.9.zip

- b. Then reboot and try to install PSCAD or the License Manager again.

Solution 2: Fix the Drive Mapping

- a. Click "Start", and then click "Control Panel".
- b. In Control Panel, double-click "Administrative Tools", and then double click "Computer Management".
- c. In the Computer Management tree, click "Disk Management".
- d. Right-click the CD-ROM or DVD-ROM drive, or the drive that contains the operating system, and then click "Change Drive Letter and Paths".
- e. Click "Change", and change it to the original drive letter. Click "OK", and then click "Close".

Solution 3: Fix the Registry

- a. Click “Start”, and then click “Run”. The Run dialog box opens.
- b. In the Open field, type “regedit”, and then click “OK”.
- c. In the Registry Editor, locate the following registry key:

```
HKEY_CURRENT_USER\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\  
Explorer\Shell Folders
```

- d. In the right pane, note the values in the “Data” column of each entry. If any value contains a drive that is not correct for your computer, right-click the entry and select “Modify”.
- e. Type the correct drive letter in the “Value data” field, and then click “OK”.
 - For example, if one of the values is "Z:\Documents and Settings\Administrator", the drive letter should be changed to a valid drive on the system, such as "C:\Documents and Settings\Administrator".
- f. Repeat steps (d) and (e) for each entry whose “Data” value contains an incorrect drive.
- g. Repeat steps (c) through (f) for each of the following registry keys:

```
HKEY_CURRENT_USER\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\  
Explorer\User Shell Folders
```

```
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion
```

```
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\  
Explorer\Shell Folders
```

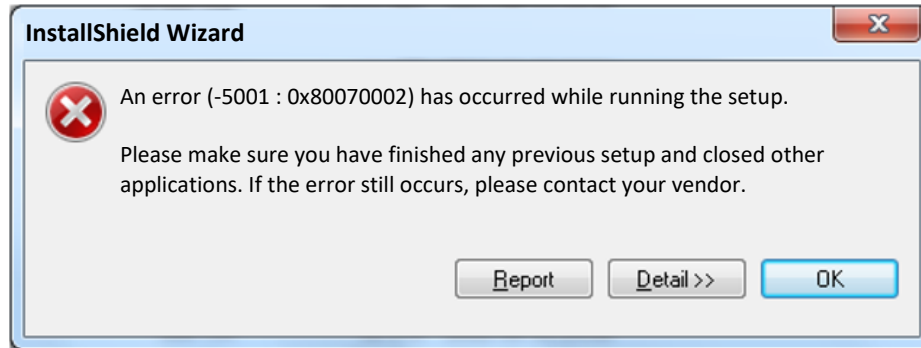
```

- h. Close the Registry Editor and run the installation again.
- i. Log out and log on again.

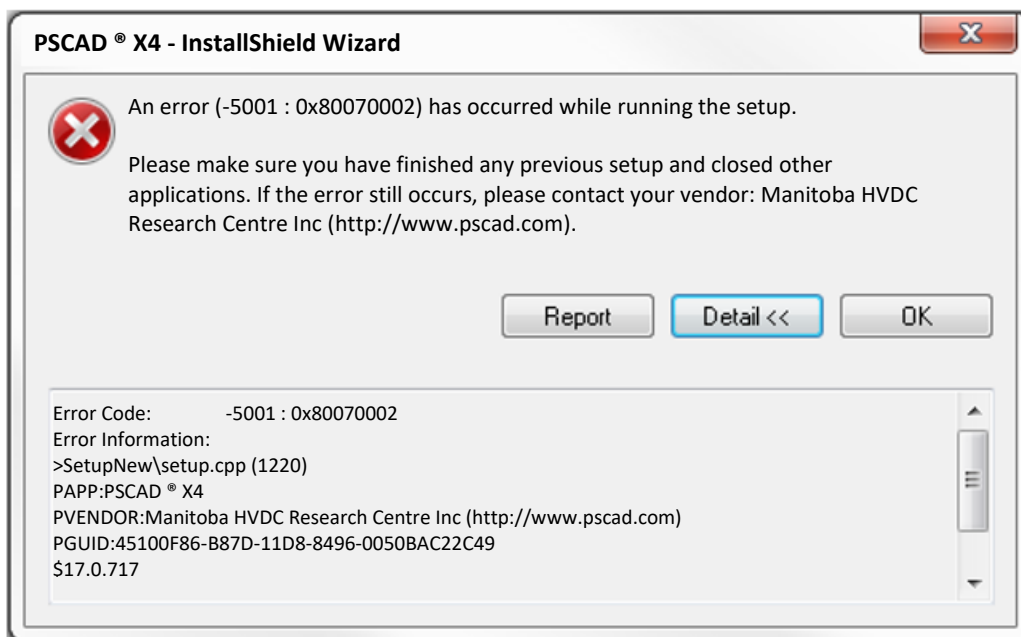
3. Installation Error -5001 (0x80070002)

Situation

When installing PSCAD or the License Manager, you encounter one of the following messages:



and with the Details visible, may look like this:



Known Incidences

- PSCAD X4 (v4.5.0, v4.5.1)

Causes

- Incomplete installation package for PSCAD only,
- Incomplete installation package for PSCAD (with License Manager, and GFortran),
- Insufficient installation rights on a machine configured as a Terminal Server.

Solution 1

The complete installation package for PSCAD only should look something like the following:

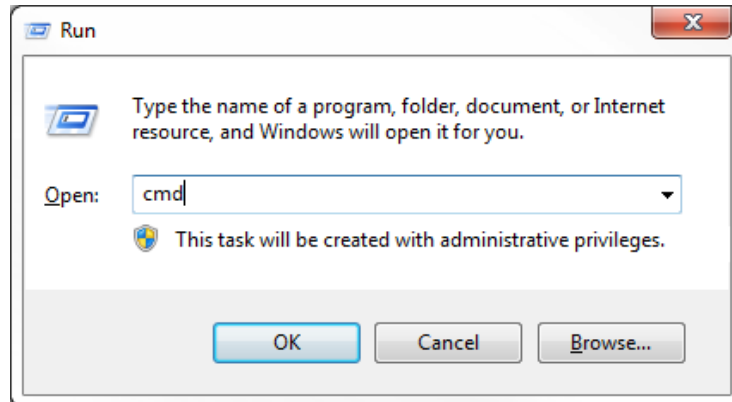

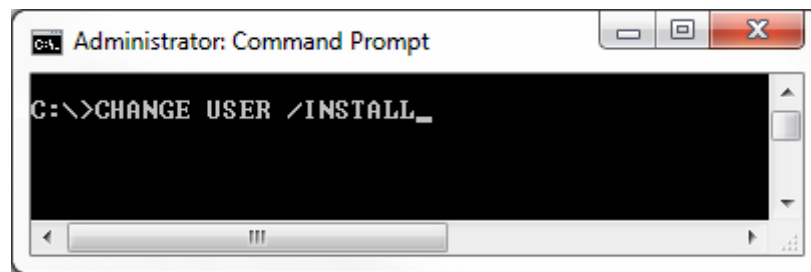

Solution 3

- a. Click "Start" -> "Run..."
- b. In the "Open" box, type "cmd", and then click "OK". See image below.



- c. At the command prompt, type "change user /install", and then press the "ENTER" key. See image below.



- d. The following message should appear:
"User session is ready to install applications."
- e. Type "exit", and then press "ENTER".
- f. From a folder on your desktop, run setup.exe again (right-click on "Setup.exe", then select "Run as administrator" (Windows 7), or "Run as Admin" (Windows Vista)) to begin the installation.

4. Installation Error -5001 (0x80070017)

Situation

When attempting to install software, the installer crashes and displays the following message:



Known Incidences

- Occurred once when installing GFortran on Windows 7/Windows Server 2008 R2 SP0.

Cause

- The CD-ROM or ZIP file containing the installer may be damaged or corrupted.

Solution

- a. Contact sales@pscad.com to obtain another CD-ROM or for instructions to obtain a downloadable ZIP file containing the necessary installer(s).

5. Installation Error -5003

Situation

When installing PSCAD or the License Manager, you encounter the following message:

Background

This error has occurred only once with PSCAD 421EVAL (no longer supported).

Solution

Unknown.

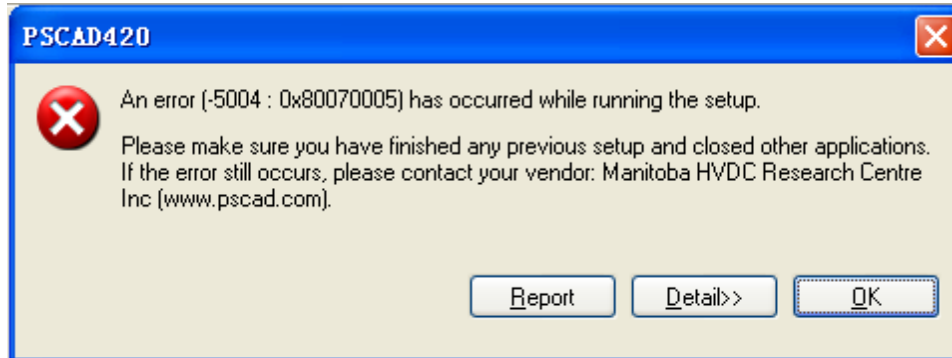
If this error occurs, please send the following information to support@pscad.com:

- Snapshots of any error messages
- Identify the following:
 - Your Windows version (i.e. Windows XP, Vista, 7, 8)
 - Your Windows platform (i.e. x86, x64)
 - Version of PSCAD or License Manager you are installing
 - The media type used for obtaining the installation files (i.e. CDROM, zip file, other)

6. Installation Error -5004 (0x80070005)

Situation

When installing PSCAD or the License Manager, you encounter the following message:



If you select the *Detail* button, you see something like the following (your exact text may be different, depending on your Windows operating system).

Background

This error occurs only very rarely. Based on our records, this error has been reported once for PSCAD v4.0.1 and PSCAD v4.2.1 on XP SP1 (no longer supported) and once for PSCAD v4.2.0 on XP SP3. This error is detected by the InstallShield engine, and not by our installation script which is processed by the InstallShield engine.

Known Incidences

- PSCAD v4.2.0 on Windows XP (32-bit) SP3
- PSCAD v4.2.1 on Windows 7 in XP compatibility mode

Possible Causes

- You do not have administrator privileges.
- You do not have access rights to the \Program Files\ folder or to the registry.

Cause 1: Attempting to Run on Windows XP SP1

If you are running Windows XP, you need to ensure that you are running the latest Service Pack.

Windows XP (32-bit) SP3 can be downloaded from here:

Windows XP (64-bit) SP2 can be downloaded from here:

Cause 2: Attempting to Install an Old Version of PSCAD

The earliest version of PSCAD that is currently supported is PSCAD v4.2.1 (2007). If you are trying to install an older version, we recommend that you upgrade to PSCAD v4.2.1 (2007) which is compatible with Windows Vista and Windows 7.

Cause 3: Attempting to Install from a Shared Network Drive

If you encounter this error when attempting to install PSCAD from an installer CD-ROM image store on a shared network drive or folder, then

- a. Insert the original PSCAD CD-ROM into your machine and launch the installer from the CD-ROM, or
- b. Copy the PSCAD installer image from the shared drive or folder onto a folder on your machine, and launch the installer from that folder.

Cause 4: Attempting to Install when in XP-Compatible Mode

This issue has also been experienced when installing onto a Window Vista or Windows 7 machine when in XP-compatible mode. If you are in this situation, and encounter this error, then

- a. If you are attempting to install PSCAD v4.2.1, ensure that you have the 2007 release, and just install PSCAD v4.2.1 on to your machine WITHOUT being in XP-compatible mode.
- b. If you are attempting to install PSCAD X4, just install PSCAD X4 on your machine WITHOUT being in XP-compatible mode.

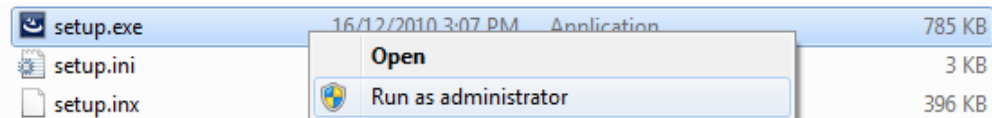
Cause 5: Installation Was Launched Without Elevated Privileges

Actions

- a. Ensure that you are directly logged in with Administrator rights. Do not log in via terminal services such as Remote Desktop, or similar.
- b. Ensure that you have read/write/modify rights to the
 - Program Files folder (for 32-bit Windows), or
 - Program Files (x86) folder (for 64-bit Windows)
- c. Ensure that you have access rights to the HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software folder in the registry
- d. If installing from a PSCAD CD-ROM...
 - Insert your PSCAD CD-ROM, and cancel any Installer that automatically launches,
 - Browse to the CD-ROM drive

If installing from a downloaded ZIP file...

- Ensure all ZIP file contents are extracted to some folder,
 - Browse to the folder.
- e. Right-click on “Setup.exe”, then select “Run as administrator” (Windows 7), or “Run as Admin” (Windows Vista) to begin the installation



Cause 6: Corrupted InstallShield Engine

Actions

- a. On XP 32, Vista (x86), or Windows 7 (x86)
 - Browse to the Program Files\Common Files folder

On XP 64, Vista (x64), or Windows 7 (x64)

 - Browse to the Program Files (x86)\Common Files folder
- b. Locate and delete the InstallShield folder
- c. On XP 32, Vista (x86), or Windows 7 (x86)
 - Browse to the Program Files folder

On XP 64, Vista (x64), or Windows 7 (x64)

 - Browse to the Program Files (x86) folder
- d. Open the InstallShield Installation Information folder
- e. If you do not see this folder, then it is hidden, and you need to make it visible.
 - On Windows XP:
 - From the File Explorer window, select Tools | Folder Options | View tab
 - Select "Show Hidden Files and Folder"
 - On Windows Vista and Windows 7:
 - From the File Explorer window, select Organize | Folder and search options | View tab
 - Select "Show hidden files, folders, and drives"

- f. Locate and delete the folder corresponding to the version of PSCAD you are trying to install

Cause 7: Temporary Folder is Full

Actions

- a. From the desktop, select Start | Run
- b. Type in the following: %temp%
- c. Select "OK"
- d. Delete the temporary files and folders
- e. Try to install PSCAD again.

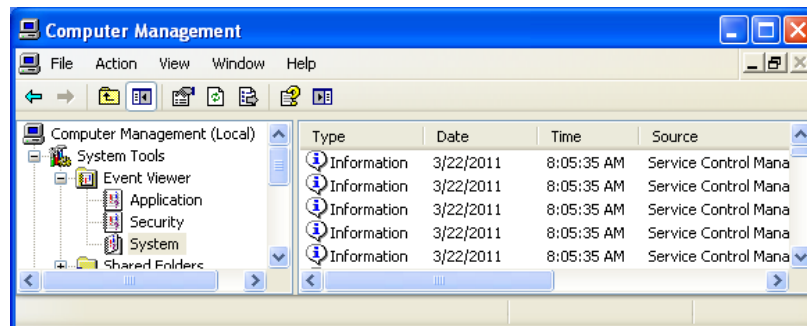
If Install Error -5004 Still Occurs

Actions

Check for any errors that appear in the “Application” and/or “System” categories in your Event Log Viewer and try to resolve them.

On Windows XP:

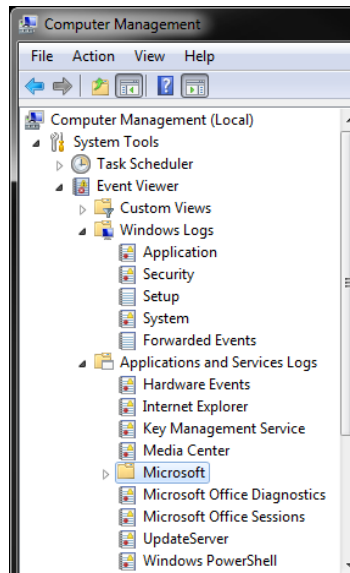
- a. Right click on “My Computer”

- d. Examine errors and warnings listed in the “Application” and “System” categories.

On Windows Vista and Windows 7:

- a. Right click on “My Computer”
- b. Select “Manage”
- c. Select System Tools | Event Viewer



- d. Examine errors and warnings listed in the Windows Log | Application category, and the Windows Log | System category
- e. Examine errors and warnings listed in the “Applications and Services Log” categories.

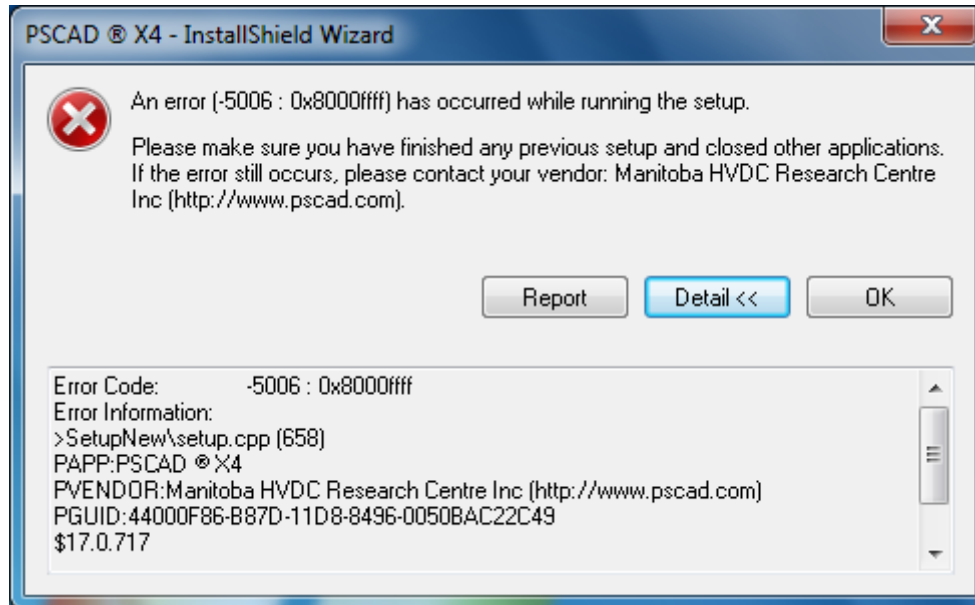

7. Installation Error -5006 (0x8000ffff)

Situation

When installing PSCAD or the License Manager, you encounter the following message:



Known Incidences

- PSCAD v4.4.0, v4.6.0

Cause

The client was running the installer's setup.exe which was located on a network file server.

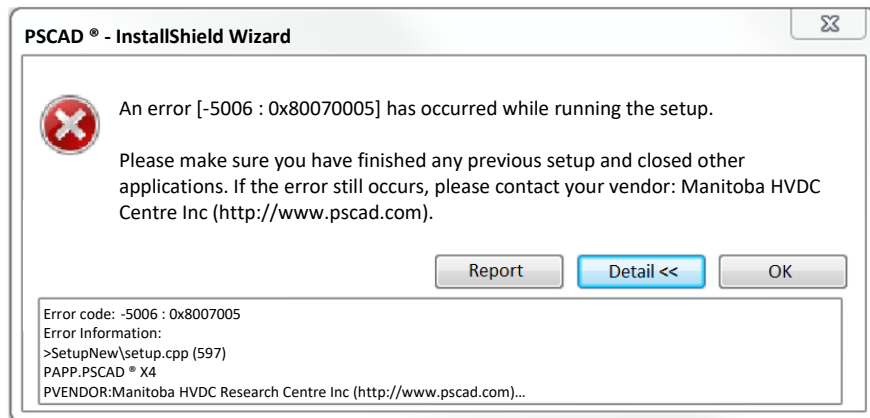
Solution

- a. Copy all of the installation files and subfolders to a folder on your local machine.
- b. Right-click on setup.exe, then select "Run as administrator" (Windows 7), or "Run as Admin" (Windows Vista) to begin the installation.

8. Receiving Error Code “-5006: 0x80070005”

Problem

When attempting to install PSCAD, the following message displays:



Cause

Antivirus software might be blocking the installation.

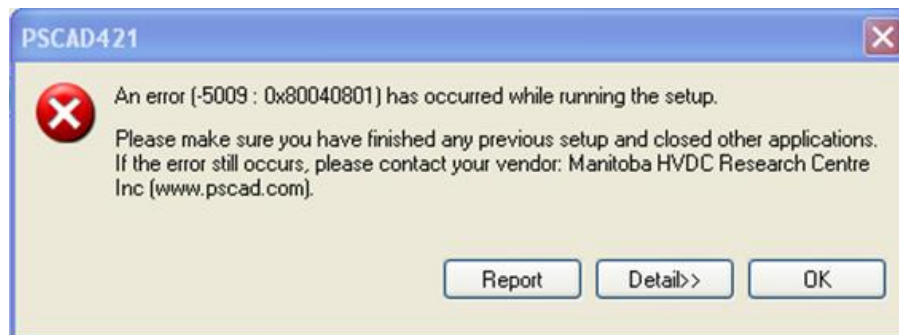
Solution

Configure your antivirus software to allow you to download a clean PSCAD installation package from [MyCentre](#) and install the software.

9. Installation Error -5009 (0x80040801)

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD or the License Manager, the installer crashes and displays the following message:



If you select the *Detail>>* button, you will see something similar to the following:

Background

When you install software using an InstallShield installer, the software installer will install or use a previously installed install engine.

Cause

If the InstallShield install engine becomes corrupted, you may encounter the error above. The solution is to re-install the install engine.

Affected Installer Versions

- The PSCAD v4.2.1 being installed on Windows XP SP3
- Not applicable to PSCAD X4

Solution 1: Update the InstallShield 7.01 Runtime Installed on your Machine

To do this, perform the following steps:

- a. Locate and delete the following folder
 - On Windows XP 64-bit, Windows Vista (x64) and Windows 7 (x64)
Program Files (x86)\Common Files\Installshield\Professional\RunTime\0701
 - On Windows XP (32-bit), Windows Vista (x86) and Windows 7 (x86)
Program Files\Common Files\Installshield\Professional\RunTime\0701

- b. Download the following file:

<http://support.installshield.com/kb/files/Q108322/InstallShieldEngineUpdate701.exe>

- c. Double-click the “InstallShieldEngineUpdate701.exe” file. This installs the latest InstallShield engine for that version of the installation.
- d. Retry installing PSCAD v4.2.1

Solution 2

Try launching PSCAD or License Manager installer by right-clicking on “Setup.exe” instead of “Setup.htm”, then selecting “Run as administrator” (Windows 7), or “Run as Admin” (Windows Vista).

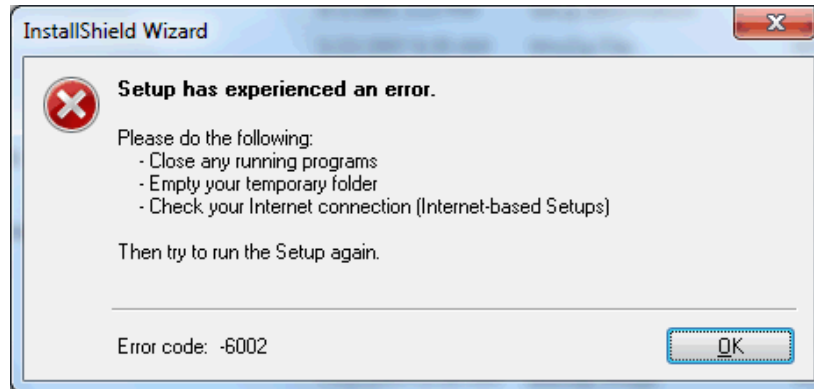
Solution 3

Try launching the setup.exe with Administrator privileges.

10. Installation Error -6002

Situation

When installing PSCAD or the License Manager, you encounter the following message:



Background

This error occurs only rarely. Based on our records, this error has been reported once in 2003 on Windows 2000 (no longer supported), and once in 2011 when installing PSCAD v4.2.1 on Windows 7. Additionally, a search of Internet – based resources reveals a large number of occurrences of this error when installing *other* software on all types of platforms, but very few solutions are offered or provided.

Cause 1: Installation Was Launched Without Elevated Privileges

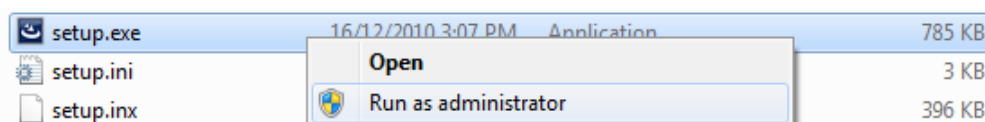
This is only applicable to Windows Vista and Windows 7.

Actions

- a. Ensure that you are logged in with Administrator rights,
- b. If installing from a PSCAD CD-ROM...
 - Insert your PSCAD CD-ROM, and cancel any Installer that automatically launches,
 - Browse to the CD-ROM drive

If installing from a downloaded ZIP file...

- Ensure all ZIP file contents are extracted to some folder,
 - Browse to the folder.
- c. Right click on Setup.exe, then select “Run as administrator” (Windows 7), or “Run as Admin” (Windows Vista) to begin the installation.



Cause 2: Too Many Programs Running

Actions

- a. Reboot your machine,
- b. Ensure that you are logged in with Administrator rights,
- c. Close any open programs,
- d. Close any applications that appear in your Task Manager (do not stop any services),
- e. Close as many programs that appear in your System Tray as possible,
- f. Install more memory.

Cause 3: Temporary Folder is too Large

- a. Locate your Temp folder and clean up files and folder in it where possible, and
- b. Try to install PSCAD again.

Cause 4: Interference from Anti-virus or Firewall Software

Actions

- a. Turn off or temporarily disable your anti-virus software, or upgrade it,
- b. If you have a firewall active, review your firewall settings. Ensure that the InstallShield setup.exe is not blocked, and
- c. Try to install PSCAD again.

Cause 5: The Installer is unable to find the Setup Launcher

This error may occur because of failing to find the setup launcher. This might happen if the "setup.boot" file (PSCAD v4.2.1 and earlier, or License Manager 1.27 and earlier) is not found or is not accessible, or if "setup.dll" does not have a proper entry point.

Actions

a. Locate and rename the following folder

- On Windows XP (32-bit), Windows Vista (x86), and Windows 7 (x86) platforms:

C:\Program Files\Common Files\InstallShield (if it exists)

- On Windows XP (64-bit), Windows Vista (x64), and Windows 7 (x64) platforms:

C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\InstallShield (if it exists)

- On Windows XP (32 or 64 bit) platforms:

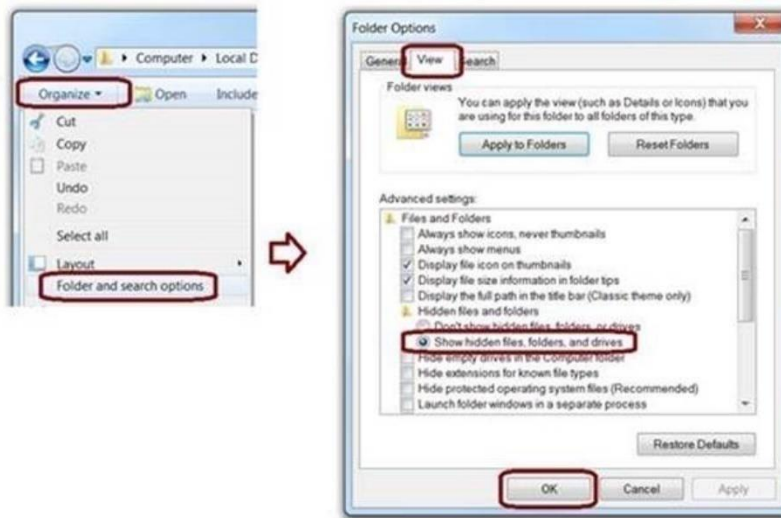
C:\Documents and Settings*YourUserID*\Application Data\InstallShield (if it exists)

- On Windows Vista and Windows 7 (x86 and x64) platforms:

C:\Users*YourUserID*\AppData\Roaming\InstallShield (if it exists)

Note

If the AppData folder is hidden, set hidden folders to display as shown:



b. On all platforms:

- Try to install PSCAD again.

Cause 6: The Installer Is run from a Folder whose Name contains a “&” Symbol

The installer has been

- downloaded from the website to, or
- copied from the installation CD-ROM to,

a folder or network location that contains a ‘&’ in the path.

Example: \\SomeMachineName\downloads & files\PSCAD\

Actions

Rename the folder which currently contains the & in its name.

Cause 7: Your Firewall Does Not Recognize One-Click Install File Extensions

If you are installing PSCAD (4.2.1 and earlier only) from a One-Click Installer on our website, your firewall might not recognize all the One-Click Install File extensions as they might not have been mapped to a known extension in the MimeMap property. This problem occurs when using Microsoft IIS 6.0. If the media extensions are not mapped correctly, IIS 6.0 will deny the request for the given file and will log a 404 error.

Actions

Edit the Multipurpose Internet Mail Exchange (MIME) map using the IIS manager, and add the One-Click Install media extensions. For example:

Extension	Content Type (MIME)
.bin	application/octet-stream
.hdr	application/octet-stream
.inx	application/octet-stream
.isn	application/octet-stream
.skin	application/octet-stream
.ibt	application/octet-stream
.boot	application/octet-stream
.ini	text/plain

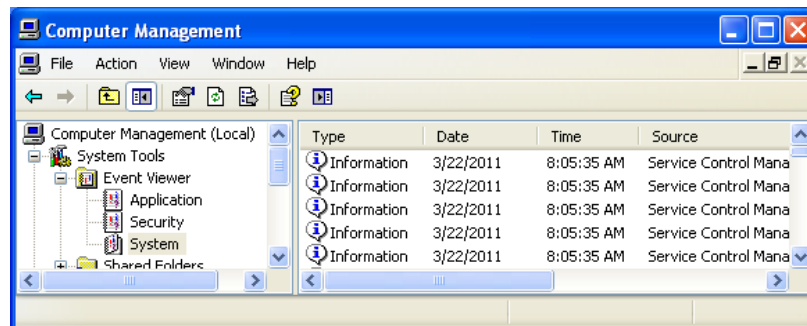
If Install Error -6002 Still Occurs

Actions

Check for any errors that appear in the “Application” and/or “System” categories in your Event Log Viewer and try to resolve them.

- c. Select System Tools | Event Viewer

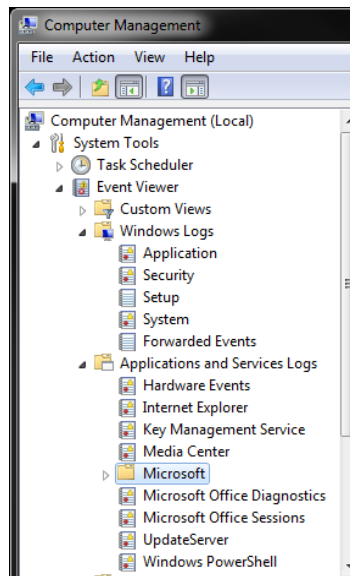

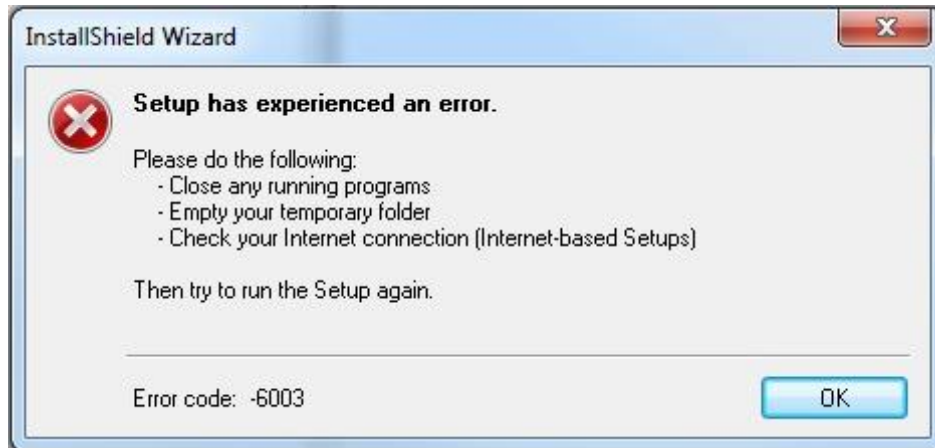

11. Installation Error -6003

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD from a CD-ROM onto a machine, the installer crashes and displays a message similar to the following:



Known Incidences

- PSCAD v4.2.0 on Windows 7.

Possible Causes

- The installer is not compatible with Windows Vista or Windows 7.
- You have too many programs open.
- Your temporary folder has too many files and folders.

Solution 1: Use the Latest Version of PSCAD

- a. Use the latest release of PSCAD.
- b. If you need to use PSCAD v4.2.1, then use the PSCAD v4.2.1 (2007) release of PSCAD.
- c. If you are using a version of PSCAD prior to PSCADv 4.2.1 (2007), then
 - Upgrade to the latest version of PSCAD X4, or
 - Upgrade to the PSCAD v4.2.1 (2007) release of PSCAD.

Solution 2: Close all other Programs

- a. Close all other active programs.
- b. Close as many programs that appear in your System Tray as possible.
- c. Try to install PSCAD again.

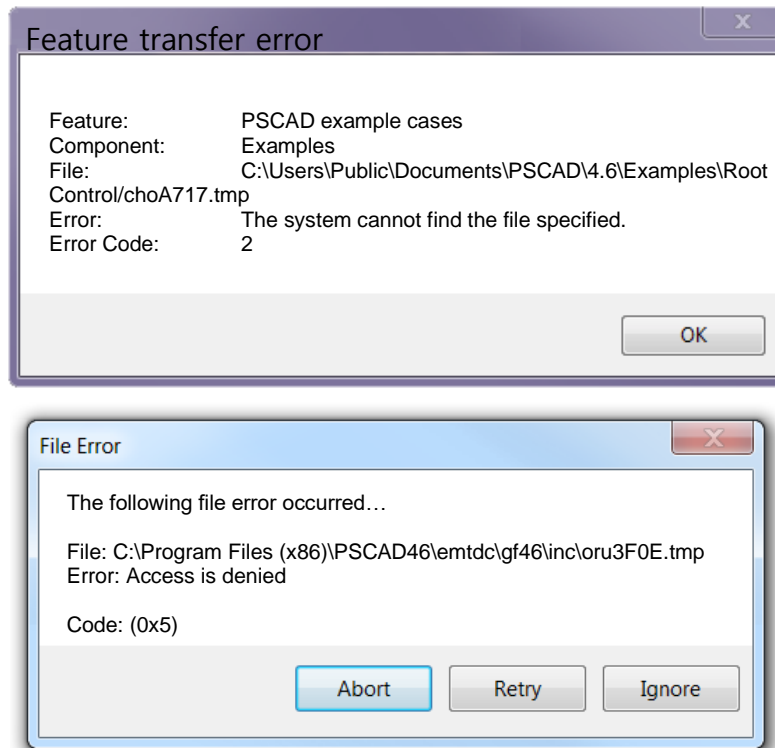
Solution 3: Clean your Temporary Folder

- a. Locate your Temp folder and clean up files and folder in it where possible, and
- b. Try to install PSCAD again.

12. Installation Error Code 2

Situation

When attempting to install software, the installer displays a message similar to the following ones (the named file may be different):



Other known file name variations in the above view:

"File: C:\Users\Public\Documents\PSCAD\4.6\Examples\optimum_run\HooA5D7.tmp"

"File: C:\Program Files (x86)\PSCAD46\Forms\images\Abo675F.tmp"

Cause

An antivirus or firewall is randomly interfering with the installation.

Solution

Have your IT staff disable or remove your antivirus during the installation.

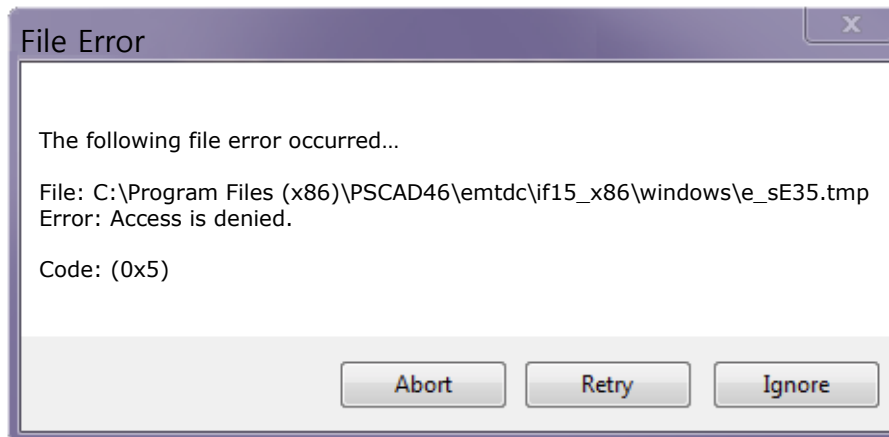
Known Incidences

The Webroot SecureAnywhere antivirus/firewall product is known to cause this issue.

13. Installation Error Code (0x5)

Situation

When attempting to install software, the installer displays a message similar to the following (the named file may be different):



Cause

An antivirus or firewall is randomly interfering with the installation.

Solution

Have your IT staff disable your antivirus during the installation, or have them remove your antivirus.

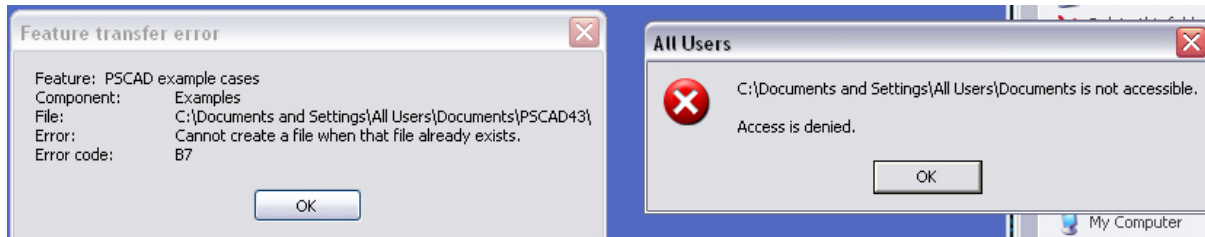
Known Incidences

The Webroot SecureAnywhere antivirus/firewall product is known to cause this issue.

14. Installation Error 0xB7

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD X4 on a machine, while logged in with administrator rights, the installer crashes and displays the following message. If I then try to browse to and access the named file, I encounter an “Access Denied” error.



Background

Generally, by default, all users should have access to the ... \All Users\Documents folder, hence the name. Additionally, note that “Documents” is an alias for the proper folder name, “Shared Documents”.

Causes

- You failed to run the installer with elevated privileges, or
- It would appear that on your machine, you do not have access to the ... \All Users\Documents folder.

Affected Installer Versions

- PSCAD X4 (4.3.0), released in April 2010.

Remedy

If you have full local admin rights on your machine, then you should be able to give yourself access to that folder.

Alternatively, ask your IT department to grant you the required permissions.

Solution 1: Run the Installer with Elevated Privileges

Re-run the installation, however, ensure that you right click on “setup.exe”, then select “Run as administrator” (Windows 7), or “Run as Admin” (Windows Vista) to begin the installation.

Solution 2: Consult Your IT Department

Ask your IT department to ensure that you have the required permissions to access to the ... \All Users\Documents folder.

15. Installation Error 0x45D

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD X4 from a CD-ROM onto a machine, the installer crashes and displays a message similar to the following:



This was followed by another message referring to an I/O error.

Possible Causes

- The PSCAD CD-ROM is corrupted or damaged, or
- The CD-ROM drive is not reliable, or
- An installed firewall or virus scanner is interfering with the installation.

Known Incidences

- PSCAD X4 (4.3.1), released in Dec 2010.

Solution 1: Run the Installer with Elevated Privileges

- a. Contact sales@pscad.com for a download link for your software.
- b. Download the software and then extract the ZIP'd files.
- c. Right-click on "Setup.exe", then select "Run as administrator" (Windows 7), or "Run as Admin" (Windows Vista) to begin the installation.

Solution 2: Install on another Machine

- a. Install the software from the received CD-ROM or downloaded ZIP files onto another machine.

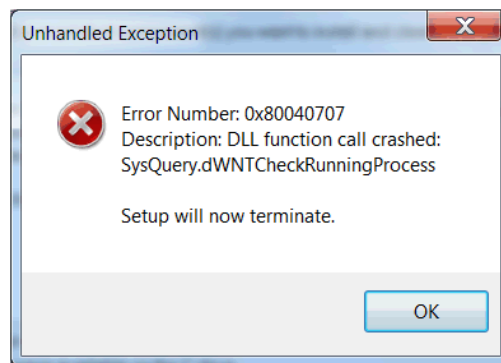
Solution 3: Change your Security Configuration

- a. Temporarily disable your virus checkers and firewall.
- b. Install the software from the received CD-ROM or downloaded ZIP files.
- c. Re-enable your virus checkers and firewalls.

16. PSCAD Installation Error 0x80040707

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD or the License Manager, the installer crashes and displays the following message, which is due to a bug in the installer code.



Background

You cannot install or repair an application if that application is already running on your machine. Therefore, when installing PSCAD or the License Manager, the installer requests a list of all running processes, so that the installer can check if either program is already running, and then notify you to stop those instances before continuing with the installation.

Cause

If you are attempting to install an older version of PSCAD or the License Manager, and your machine has many running processes, then this request may fail with the error shown above.

Affected Installer Versions

- The PSCAD v4.2.1 (2006) release of PSCAD and earlier.
- The License Manager 1.26 release and earlier.

Solution(s)

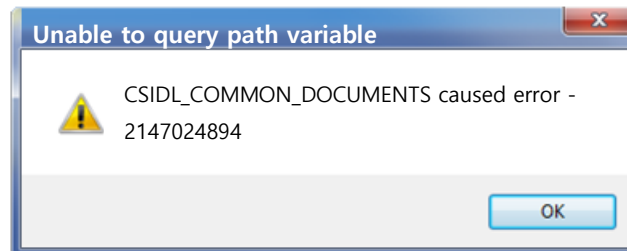
The installer code cannot be repaired, however, there are several things that you can do to work around this issue.

- a. Use the latest release of PSCAD.
- b. If you need to use PSCAD v4.2.1, then use the PSCAD v4.2.1 (2007) release of PSCAD.
- c. If you are using a version of PSCAD prior to PSCAD v4.2.1 (2007), then
 - Upgrade to the latest version of PSCAD X4, or
 - Upgrade to the PSCAD v4.2.1 (2007) release of PSCAD.
- d. Reduce the number of running applications and services, then try to install PSCAD or the License Manager
- e. Install PSCAD on another machine which does not have so many active services

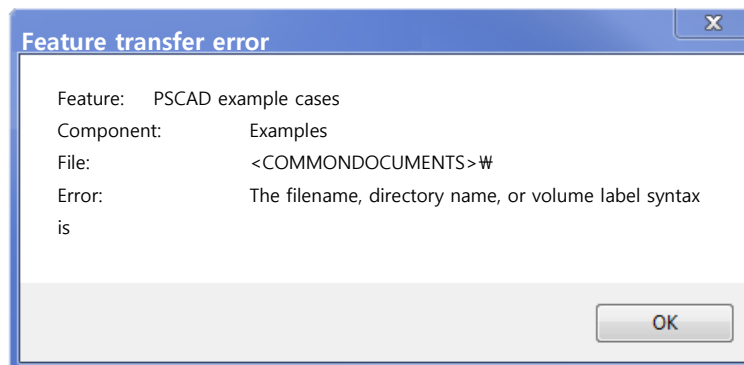
17. Installation Error 0x80070002 (-2147024894)

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD from a CD-ROM onto a machine, the installer crashes and displays a message similar to the following:



This will most likely be followed by the following error message after the installation begins:



Error -2147024894 corresponds to error 0x80070002 which means “File not found”. Error 7B corresponds to “Invalid file, directory, or volume name”.

Possible Causes

- COMMONDOCUMENTS is missing from .NET 3.5.
- You do not have administrator privileges.
- You do not have access rights to the \Program Files\ folder or to the registry.

Known Incidences

- PSCAD v4.2.0 on Windows XP SP3.
- PSCAD X4: 4.4.1 and 4.6.0

Solution 1: Ensure you have Administrator Privileges

- a. Contact your IT department to ensure that you have local administrator privileges.
- b. Right-click on “Setup.exe”, then select “Run as administrator” (Windows 7), or “Run as Admin” (Windows Vista) to begin the installation.

Solution 2: Ensure the Common Document Registry Value is Correct

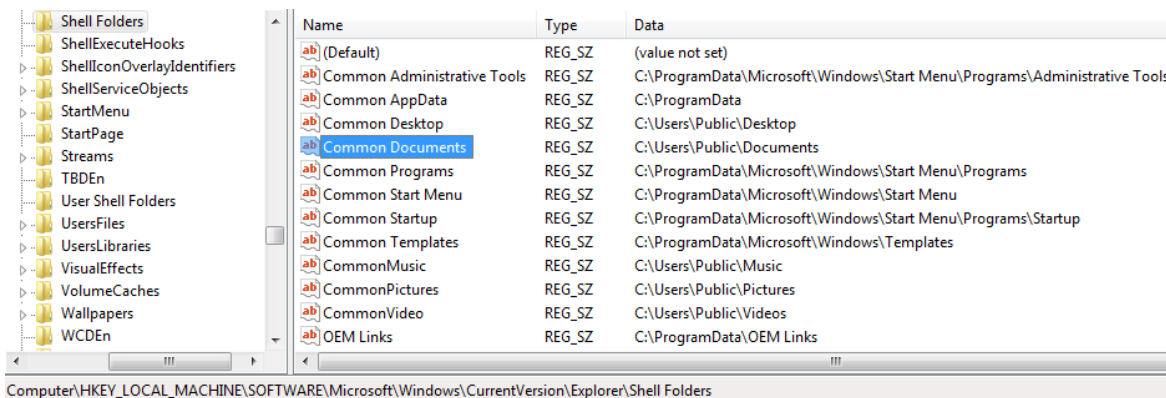

Causes

- The Microsoft .NET 4.0 Framework Full is not installed prior to installing PSCAD, or
- The Microsoft .NET 4.0 Framework Full was installed, but the user did not allow the installer to reboot when prompted, and just continued the installation.

Known Incidences

- PSCAD v4.5.0, v4.5.1 (actually any installation of 4.5.0 and better)

Solution 1: Install the Latest Version of PSCAD

- a. Install the latest release of PSCAD, currently at PSCAD X4 (4.5.5) which will install the .NET 4.0 Framework Full before installing PSCAD. Make sure that you launch the setup.exe with elevated administrator privileges.
- b. If the installer prompts you to reboot or restart, allow it to do so.
- c. Re-launch the installer with elevated administrator privileges.

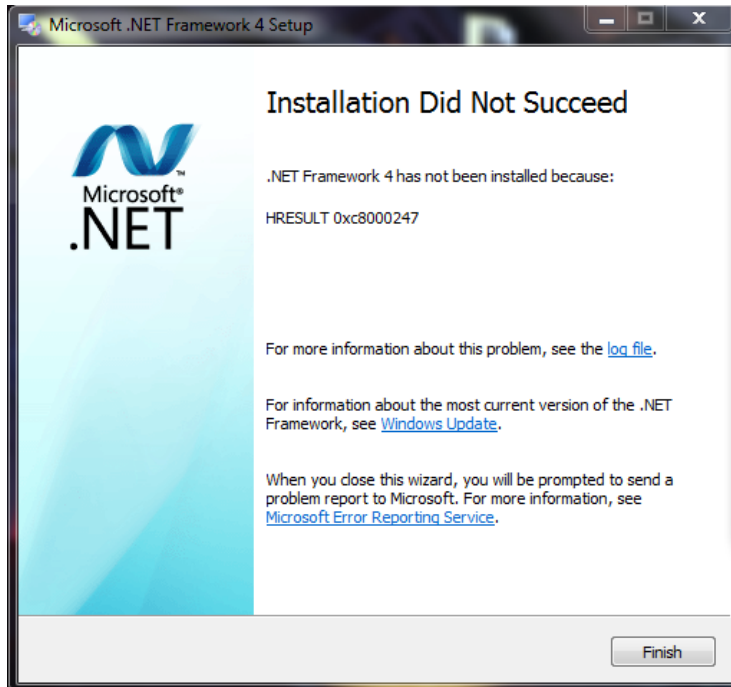

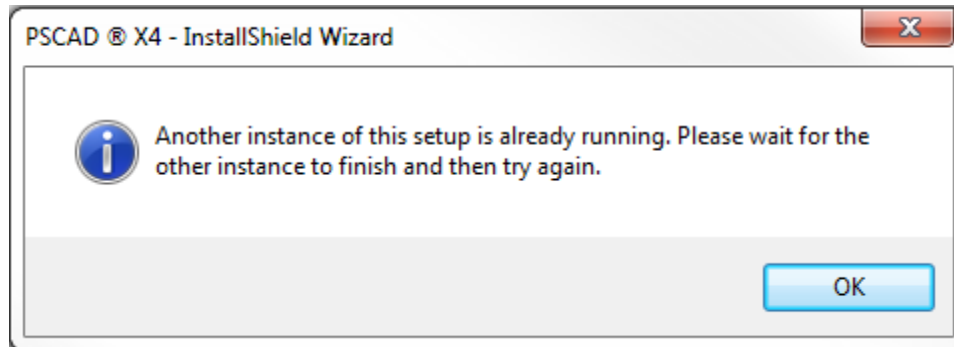

22. Installation Error - .NET Download Failed

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD onto a machine, the Microsoft .NET 4.0 Framework completes with the following error message.



Cause

- Unknown

Known Incidences

- PSCAD X4 (4.5.0)

Solution

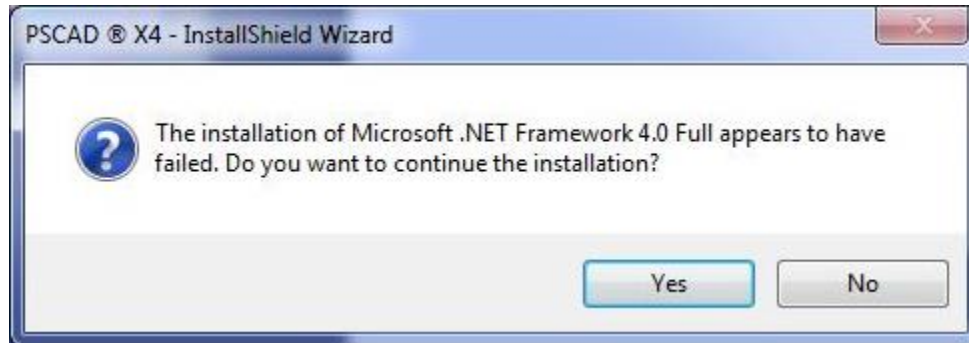

23. Installation Error - .NET Installation Failed

Situation

Suggested Actions

- a. Select Start.
- b. Type in "Windows Update". See image below. Press "ENTER".



- c. This will launch the Windows Update utility. There may be some software that is missing on your computer for this installation, and this utility can detect it and install it.
- d. Ensure that updates are enabled.

24. Installation Error: Missing SysQuery.dll

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD from a CD-ROM onto a machine, the installer crashes and displays a message claiming that the following file is missing:

{alphanumericstring}\SysQuery.dll
```

Background

During the installation, installation files are extracted to a temporary folder on the user's machine.

For PSCAD v4.5.1, the installer extracts its working files to:

C:\Users\Iha.CENTRE\AppData\Local\Temp\{some_string}\
{45100F86-B87D-11D8-8496-0050BAC22C49}
```

For PSCAD v4.5.0, the installer extracts its working files to:

```
C:\Users\Iha.CENTRE\AppData\Local\Temp\{some_string}\
{45000F86-B87D-11D8-8496-0050BAC22C49}
```

And so on.

You can determine what `{some_string}` is by looking into the most recent folders created in the `\Temp` folder and looking for one which has a `...{4500...}` or `{451...}`, etc, subfolder.

The extracted working files remain in this folder even after the installation is complete.

Possible Causes

- A virus scanner is prohibiting the installation of some files, or is deleting some files after installation.
- You did not login with administrator privileges.
- You did not launch the setup.exe with elevated privileges.

Known Incidences

- PSCAD v4.5.0

Solution 1: Use the Latest Version of PSCAD

- a. Install the latest release of PSCAD. Make sure that you launch the setup.exe with elevated administrator privileges.

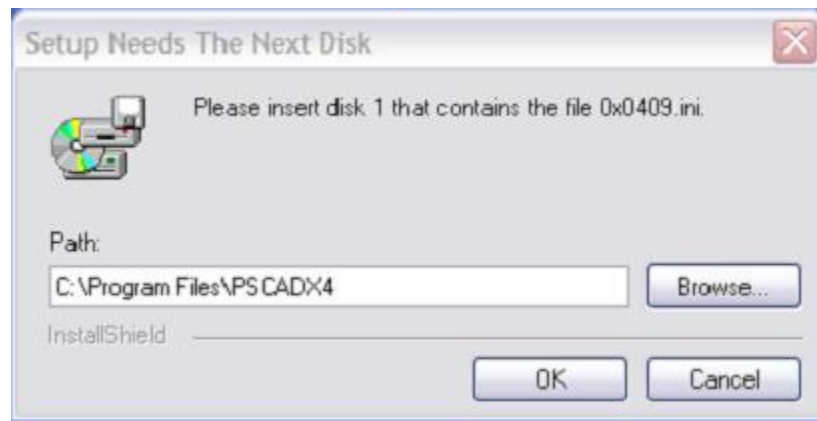
Solution 2: Manually Copy Files

- a. On the affected machine(s), start the PSCAD installer. This will create the ...\\Temp\\(some_string) folder
- b. If the installer is unable to find these expected files, it will abort or crash.

 - For PSCAD v4.5.0, only copy from a ...\\Temp\\...\\{4500...} folder to a ...\\Temp\\...\\{4500...} folder.
 - And so on...
- d. Then try to re-run the installer on the machine which fails.

25. Installation Error 'Please insert disk 1'

Situation

When attempting to install PSCAD from a ZIP file folder, the installer crashes and displays a message similar to the following:



Possible Cause 1

You are launching the installer from within a ZIP file, without first unzipping the files.

Known Incidence 1

- PSCAD X4 (4.3.1).

Solution 1

If you received our software in a ZIP file, you need to do the following:

- a. Save the ZIP file to a temporary folder on your machine.
- b. Extract all of the ZIP'd files and folders to a second temporary folder on your machine.
- c. Browse to the second temporary folder, right-click on "Setup.exe", then select "Run as administrator" (Windows 7), or "Run as Admin" (Windows Vista) to begin the installation.

Possible Cause 2

You are launching the installer from a Network drive.

Known Incidence 2

PSCAD v5.0.1

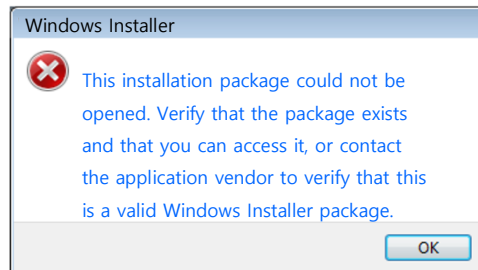
Solution 2

26. Installation Error – Unable to Start Sentinel Installer

When attempting to install PSCAD or the License Manager onto a machine, the Sentinel Driver installer shows the following error message.

- Unknown

Known Incidences

- PSCAD X4 (4.4.0) on Windows 7 (32-bit)

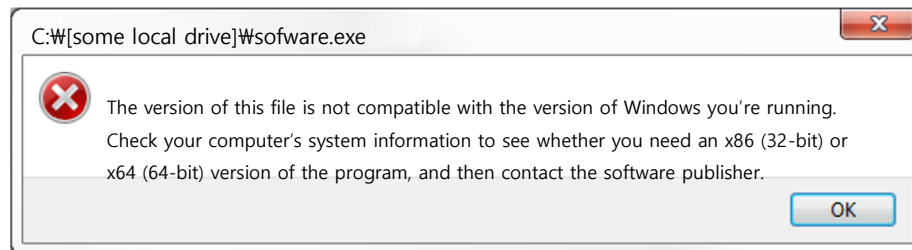

- The downloaded installer ZIP file was renamed to an EXE file.

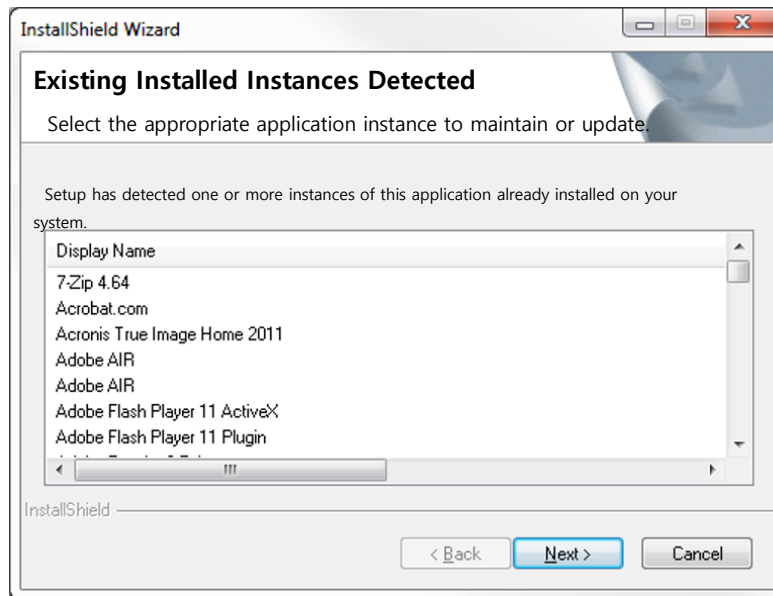

- a. Download the installation ZIP file from the link provided from PSCAD support, without renaming it to an EXE filename.
- b. Extract all files from the ZIP file.
- c. Ensure that you are logged in with Administrator rights,
- d. Right-click on setup.exe, then select "Run as administrator" (Windows 7), or "Run as Admin" (Windows Vista) to begin the installation.

28. Installation Error – Existing Installed Instances Detected

Situation

When installing PSCAD, the License Manager, or GFortran, you encounter a dialog similar to the following:



Causes

This error has been observed to occur when the PSCAD installation files have been stored on a Linux Ubuntu file server and the Setup.ini and/or 0x0409.ini installer files have been somehow corrupted.

The image below compares a perfect setup.ini file (left pane) with a corrupted setup.ini file (right pane). Notice that in the corrupted file,

- Some lines are missing, and
- It appears that non-English characters have been inserted. It has been verified that these are just random, meaningless characters.

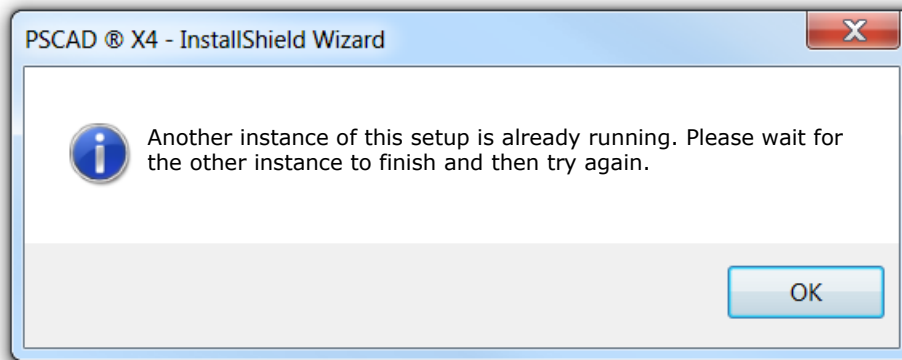

29. Receiving an “Another instance of this setup is already running” Message

Problem

When running the installation, the following warning displays:



Cause

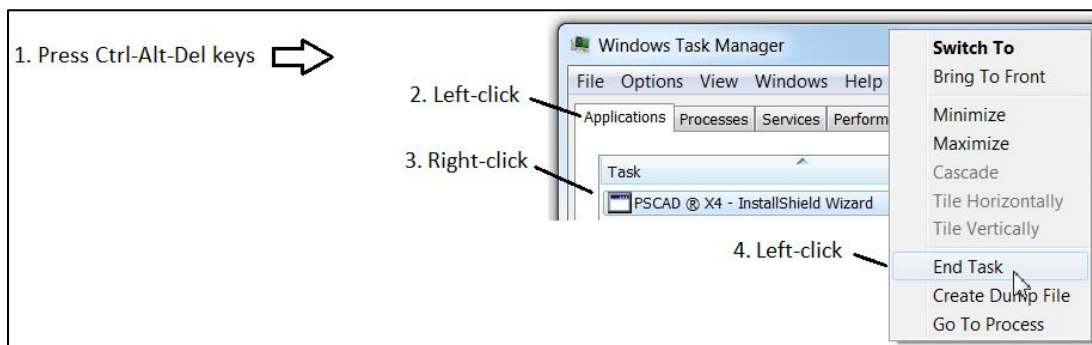
Two instances of the InstallShield were invoked.

InstallShield does not permit two installations of the same or different software to run concurrently. The above warning is displayed if this detected.

Solution

Close out of all instances of InstallShield, then retry the installation.

If the above solution does not work, then an installation may be “hung up” and running as a background process. Stop all instances of InstallShield as follows:

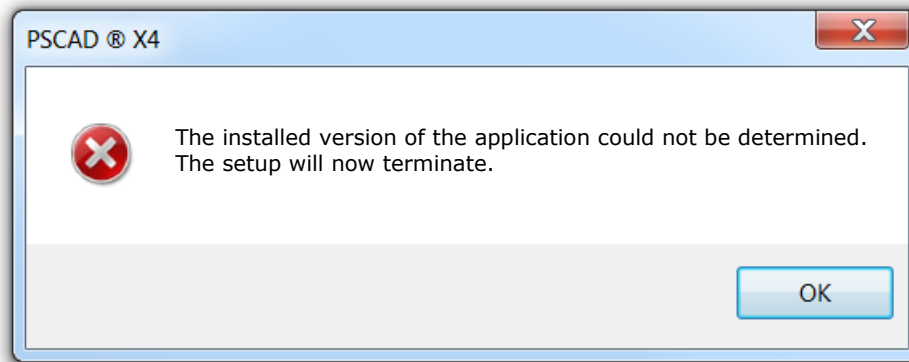

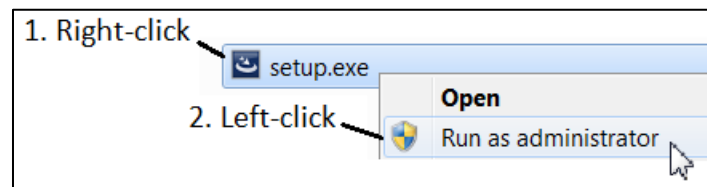

31. Error 28 When Installing Sentinel Drivers on Windows 8.1

Background

The PSCAD and License Manager installers both install Sentinel USB drivers so that the programs can detect the Sentinel USB lock.

Problem

When the PSCAD or Licence Manager installers install the Sentinel drivers on Windows 8.1, the driver installation sometimes fails with an error 28.

Cause

It appears that many drivers which were compatible with Windows 7 and Windows 8 are not compatible with Windows 8.1.

Solution

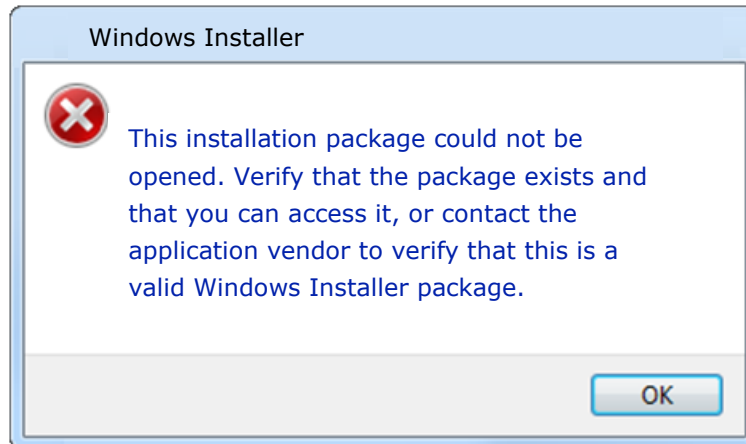
Install the latest Sentinel USB drivers which are compatible with Windows 8.1, then install PSCAD and/or the License Manager which will then detect the newer installed drivers, and will not attempt to install the older, incompatible drivers.

- Download and install the latest Sentinel drivers from here:

32. Receiving a "This installation package could not be opened" Error Message when Installing Sentinel Drivers

Problem

Installing the Sentinel Drivers results in the following error message:



Cause

One or more of the following requirements is not being met:

- You require administrator privileges on your machine to perform this installation.
- Any firewall or antivirus programs that may interfere with this installation should be disabled. One example of a software that blocks installations is "AppSense".
- The installation files should be run from a folder in which you have permission.
- The installation files should be run from a local driver (i.e. not a network drive).

Solution

- Ensure that you meet all requirements listed above.
- Install the Sentinel Drivers as outlined in the manual "Installing PSCAD X4", located on the following webpage:

33. Silent Installation Stalls

Problem

When running the silent installation for PSCAD from the RecordSilentInstall.bat file, the installation stalls.

Cause

This issue occurs when a user does not have administrator rights on a computer.

System

This issue occurs only in v4.5.4. It has been fixed in later versions; previous versions do not provide for silent installation.

Solution 1

Switch to v4.5.5 or later.

Solution 2

Log out of the computer, then log in using administrator credentials.

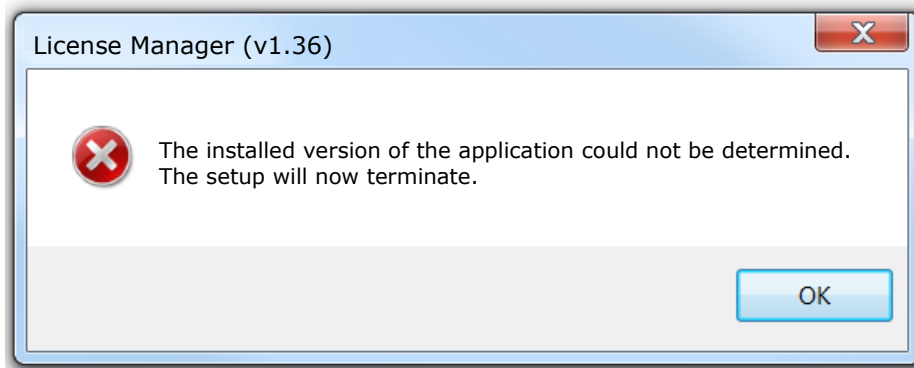

34. Receiving “The setup will now terminate” Error Message

Problem

During an installation, the following error message displays:



Cause

You attempted to run the installation from a zipped file.

Solution

Unzip the file, then run the installation.

35. Visual Studio (Shell Edition) will not install alongside Intel Fortran 16

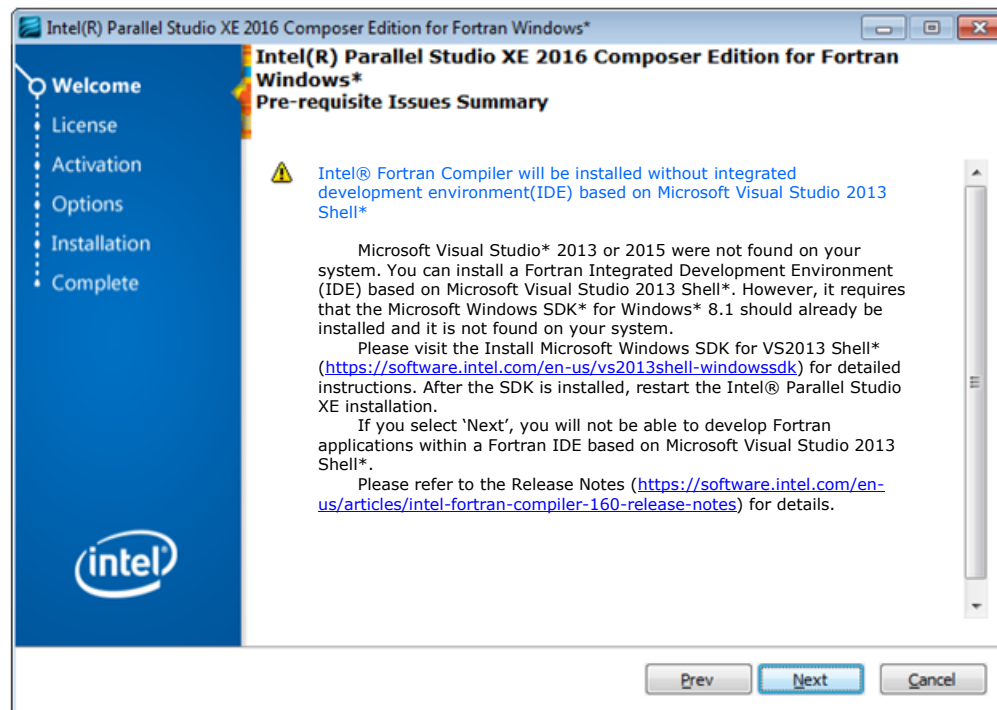
Problem

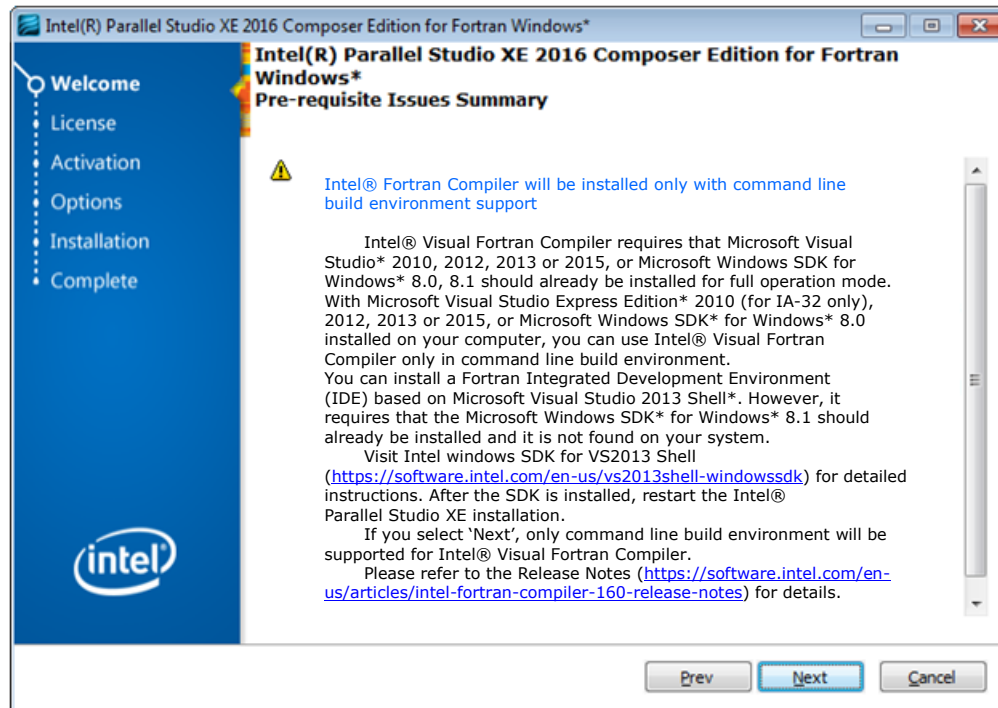
When installing Intel Parallel Studio XE 2016 Composer Edition for Fortran Windows (Intel Fortran 16), the Microsoft Visual Studio 2013 Shell Edition that comes bundled with it does not install.

Note

When compiling PSCAD cases using Intel Fortran 16, an appropriate Visual Studio edition must also be installed.

During the Intel Fortran 16 installation, a message similar to one of the following two messages will display:





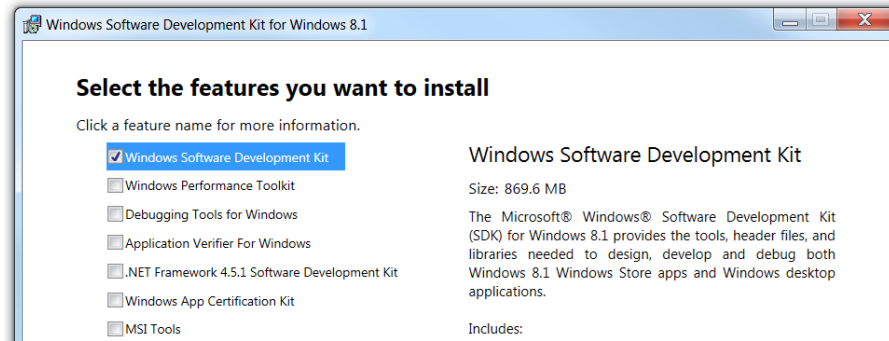
Cause

You are running the installation of Intel Fortran 16 on a machine that does not already have the prerequisite software: Microsoft Windows SDK for Windows 8.1. The Visual Studio software that comes bundled with Intel Fortran 16 cannot be installed without this prerequisite software.

Solution

- Shut down the Intel Fortran 16 installation.
- Go to the following link:

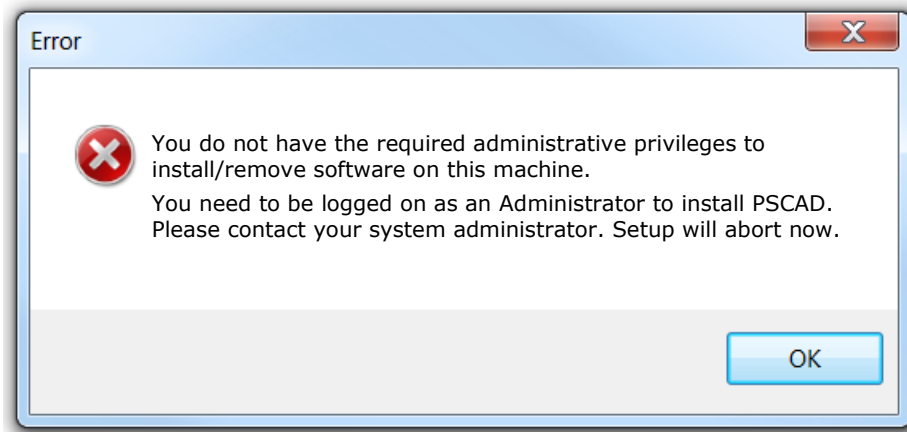

36. Error Message is Displayed: “You do not have the required administrative privileges...”

Problem

When launching the PSCAD InstallShield Wizard installation, the following message is displayed, and the setup is halted:



Cause

The installation requires permission to write to restricted locations on the machine.

Solution

Obtain administrative privileges on the machine, then restart the installation.

37. Unable to Update or Install the .NET Framework

Problem

When attempting to install a .NET Framework (any version), you encounter one of the following errors:

Installation success or error status: 1603

Error 0x80070643

Error 997. Overlapped I/O operation error – 0x8007063

Cause

This is a known issue with the security patch KB2918614 released on August 12, 2014. This issue occurs because update 2918614 uses cryptographic keys and certificates for hashing the installation files together with the logged-in user profile. However, cryptographic keys and certificates cannot be used by mandatory or temporary user profiles. Therefore, when a user uses a mandatory or temporary user profile to install any MSI package, the MSI package installation fails and the error message returns.

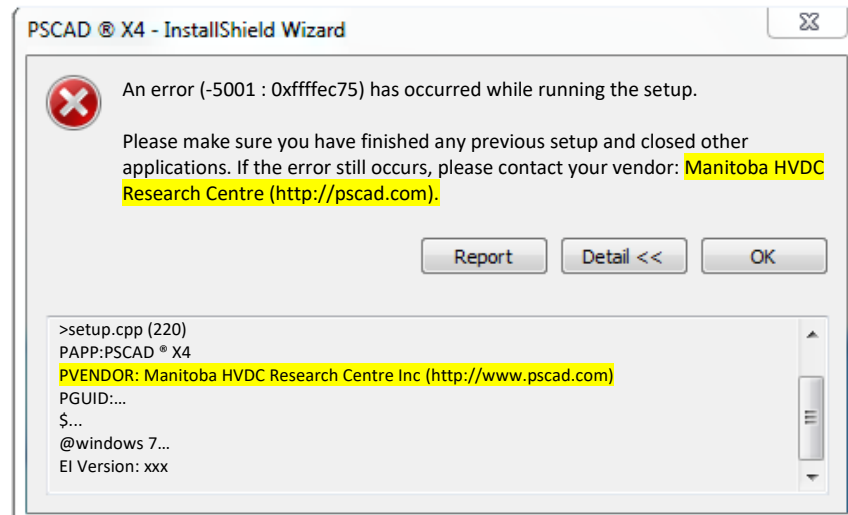
Solution

- b. Ensure you have full ownership of it, or have the owner log in

38. Receiving an “Error 5001 : 0xffffec75” Error Message

Problem

When attempting to install PSCAD, the following error displays:



Cause

The user's anti-virus is stripping some of the installation folders when they are downloaded and extracted from the zipped folder. When the installation is run, this process fails due to the missing folders.

One or more of the following anti-virus software may be responsible for this:

- Microsoft Security Client 4.7.0214.0
- System Center Endpoint Protection 4.7.214.0
- Windows Defender

Solution

- Decommission the anti-virus software.
- Create a new folder on your desktop.
- Download the PSCAD software installation files.
- Open the downloaded zipped file, select all of the files and copy them, then paste the copied files to the new folder on your desktop.

Note

Do not “extract” the files.

- Run the installation from the copied files.
- Reinstate the anti-virus software.

39. Receiving an “Error 0x80070652” Error Message

Problem

When attempting to install Visual C++ 2015 redistributable, the following errors display:

[1810:2128][2017-01-05T14:03:02]e000: Error 0x80070652: Failed to execute MSU package.
```

```
[1540:1784][2017-01-05T14:03:02]e000: Error 0x80070652: Failed to configure per-machine MSU package.
```

Cause

A background update of the client’s machine by IT was in progress. Since only one installation can be active at a time, the second installation, the redistributables, was blocked and aborted.

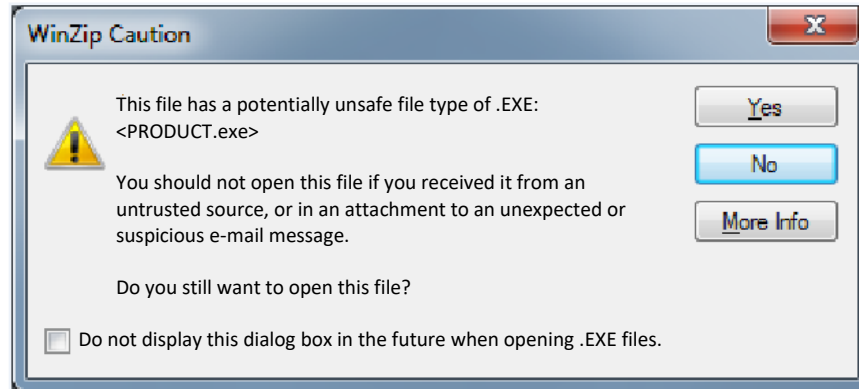

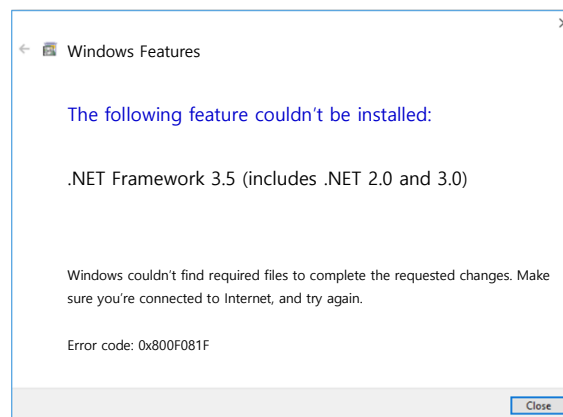
42. Issues when installing PSCAD v4.4 or License Manager v1.29 or v1.30 on Windows 10

Problem

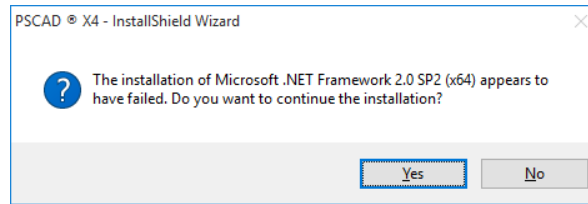
When installing PSCAD 4.4.0 or 4.4.1, or License Manager v1.29 or v1.30 (bundled with PSCAD v4.4.0 or v4.4.1) on Windows 10, you will be prompted to install .NET Framework 2.0. When you select “OK”, you will be prompted to install .NET Framework 3.5 (which includes 2.0 and 3.0):



If you select “Download and install this feature” in the above view, it will attempt to download the file. This will fail, and the error code 0x800F081F will display:



Selecting “Close” in the above view will display the following:



Selecting “Yes” will allow the PSCAD or License Manager installation to complete.

Cause

.NET Framework 2.0, 3.0, and 3.5 are not supported on Windows 10.

Error 0x800F081F indicates that the source files for .NET Framework 3.5 could not be found.

Workaround for .NET Framework 3.5 (not recommended)

Searches on the internet reveal some suggestions for installing .NET 3.5 on Windows 10. We do not recommend trying these workarounds: If you do attempt this, you do so at your own risk.

Solution (attempting to install PSCAD 4.4.0 or 4.4.1 on Windows 10)

- a. Install PSCAD v4.4, and ignore the .NET Framework installation error messages. The PSCAD v4.4 installation will continue to completion.

Testing has revealed that even if .NET Framework 2.0 and 3.5 have not been installed, PSCAD v4.4 will still launch, and will compile cases using GFortran.

Note

Testing did not include compiling PSCAD cases using any other compilers (e.g. Intel or Compaq).

- b. Or, install our latest PSCAD software on Windows 10 instead, v4.6.1. Although not officially supported on this operating system, some customers are currently using this setup. Contact our Sales Desk for this download (ensure to include your license number in your request).

Note

Install v4.5.5 instead of v4.6 if you will be using the Compaq Fortran compiler; this compiler is not supported as of v4.6.

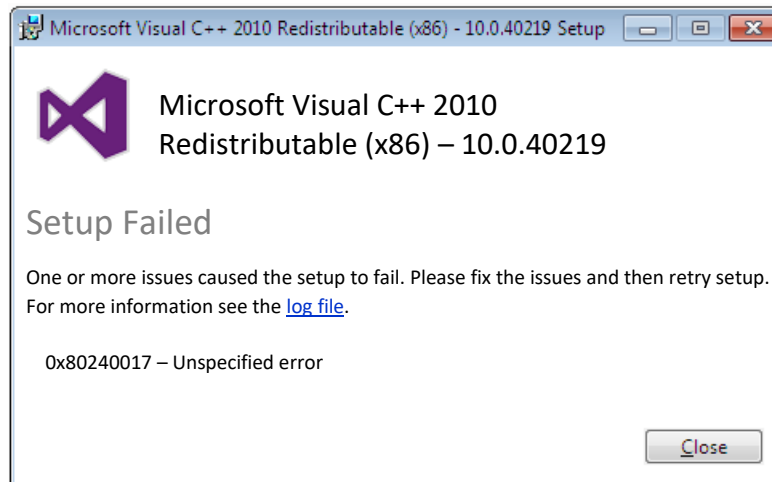
Solution (attempting to install License Manager 1.29 or 1.30 on Windows 10)

Download our latest [License Manager 1.42](#) and install this version instead of v1.29 or v1.30, as per Section 2.5 of [Installing and Licensing PSCAD](#). This version has Windows 10-compatible drivers, and will install and run on Windows 10.

43. Installation Error “0x80240017 – Unspecified error”

Problem

When installing PSCAD 4.6.0 or 4.6.1 on Windows 7 (no service packs), the following error message displays:



Cause

The Visual C++ 2010 redistributables need files only available in the Windows 7 Service Pack 1 update.

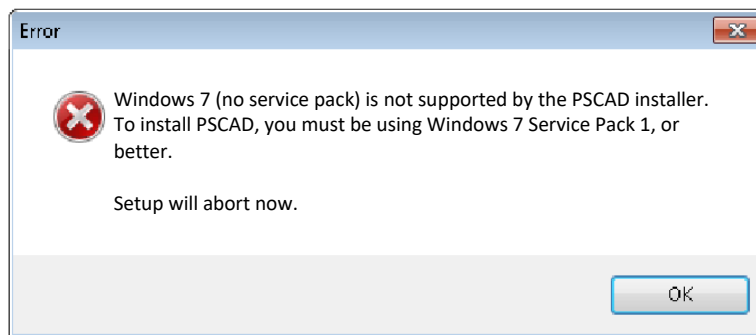
Solution

Install Windows 7 Service Pack 1 update, then install PSCAD.

44. Installation Error – “Windows 7 (no service pack) is not supported by the PSCAD installer”

Problem

When attempting to install PSCAD 4.6.0 or v4.6.1 on either Windows 7 (no service packs) or Windows Server 2008 R2 (no service packs), the following error message displays:

**Cause**

This installation requires Windows 7 SP1 or Windows Server 2008 R2 SP1.

Solution

Update your operating system to Service Pack 1, then retry the installation.

45. Receiving a Windows Defender Error Message

Problem

When attempting to install PSCAD on a Windows 10 machine, Windows Defender displays a warning message that this installation is a potential risk.

Cause

Windows Defender is set too aggressively.

Solution

In the warning message, select the option to view additional information, then select the option to proceed with the installation.

46. Unable to install PSCAD on a machine using Beyond Trust

Problem

User is unable to install PSCAD on a machine using Beyond Trust.

Solution

Contact the Beyond Trust support staff for assistance.

47. Unable to install PSCAD v4.2.1 on a Windows 10 Machine

Problem

User is unable to install PSCAD v4.2.1 on a Windows 10 machine.

When the installation is executed, the PSCAD logo displays briefly, then disappears. There is nothing further, the installation has somehow terminated.

Cause

Exploit Protection software has been known to block the PSCAD v4.2.1 installation.

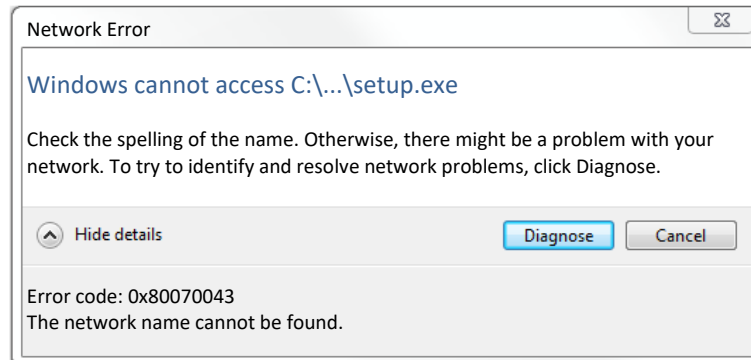
Solution

Whitelist the PSCAD installation file (setup.exe) in the Exploit Protection software settings.

48. Receiving a “The network name cannot be found” Error Message

Problem

When attempting to install PSCAD, the following message displays:



Cause (1)

Protection software might be deleting or quarantining the files.

Solution (1)

Turn off your protection software and retry the installation.

Cause (2)

There might be a problem with the location of the software installation files.

Solution (2)

Download and extract the software installation files to a different (local) folder on your machine.

Cause (3)

There may be a problem with your network.

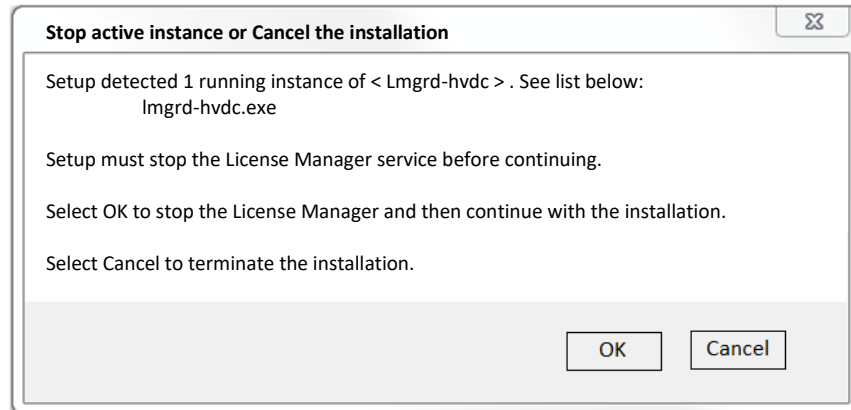
Solution (3)

Move your machine to a different network (e.g. home), and try the installation from there.

49. Receiving a “Stop active instance or Cancel the installation” Error Message

Problem

When attempting to install PSCAD, the following message displays:



Cause

The License Manager for managing multi-user licenses has been detected as running. This software must be stopped before the installation may proceed.

Solution

Select “OK” as shown in the above view, to stop the License Manager software, then proceed with the installation.

50. Receiving a “Setup Completed. However, not all features installed correctly” Error Message when Installing Microsoft® Visual Studio

Problem

When attempting to install Visual Studio from a shared drive, the installation proceeds, however, errors similar to the following display after the installation has completed:



Cause

The installation was launched from a shared drive; it should have been launched from a local drive.

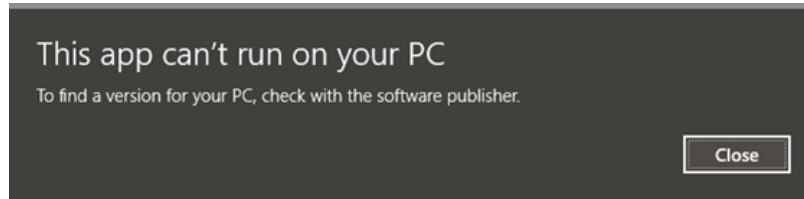
Solution

- Save the Visual Studio installation files to your desktop.
- Uninstall Visual Studio.
- Re-install Visual Studio from the desktop files.

51. Receiving a “This app can’t run on your PC” Error Message when attempting to run the PSCAD Installation Package

Problem

When attempting to install the PSCAD installation package (or launch PSCAD), you encounter the following error:



Cause (1)

When the zipped PSCAD installation files were downloaded, protection software stripped the file extension (.zip), and the user incorrectly added the file extension as “.exe”. For example:

PSCAD v4.6.3 Update 5 - Software.**exe**

Solution (1)

Download the PSCAD installation files, and when the file extension is stripped from the ZIP file, add .zip to the filename. For example:

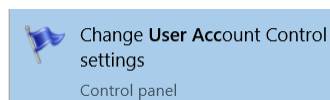

Rerun the Visual Studio installer, and select the option to “repair”.

53. Receiving an “Access Denied” Error Message when Installing from the PSCAD Installation Package

Problem

When attempting to perform an installation using the PSCD Installation Package, you encounter an “Access Denied” error message.

(also See Section 1.14)

Cause

Installation permissions are missing on your machine.

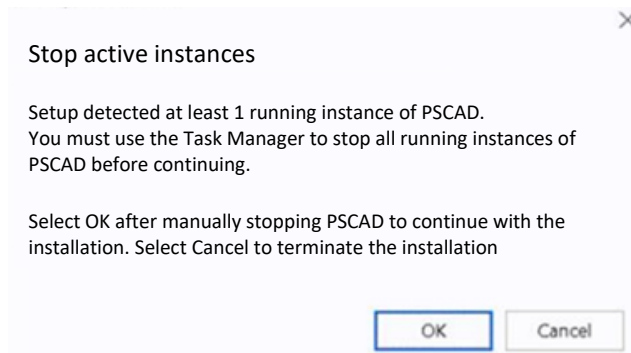
Solution

Use the Fortran Medic utility to configure for installation permissions as per Appendix A.

54. Receiving an “Setup detected at least 1 running instance of PSCAD” Error Message

Problem

When attempting to install PSCAD using the InstallShield Wizard, the following error displays:



Cause

The InstallShield installer uses a ProcessFinder utility to detect if PSCAD is running before it allows the user to proceed with installing PSCAD, because if PSCAD is running, the install will most likely fail somewhere.

Situation 1

One or more instances of PSCAD are open.

Solution 1 – Close all instances of PSCAD

Close all instances of PSCAD, then select the “OK” button in the error dialog, and the installation should proceed alright.

Situation 2

All instances of PSCAD are closed and the installation is restarted, but the error displays again.

Solution 2-1 – Perform Diagnostics to Determine the Cause

Special diagnostics have been added to the ProcessFinder utility which can be used to determine what is apparently confusing PSCAD.

Select the “Cancel” button in the error dialog, then perform the following:

- Download the following file:
<http://updater.pscad.com/utilities/ProcessFinder.zip>
- Extract the ProcessFinder.exe file from the ZIP file.
- Launch the PSCAD installer and run it until you see the dialog above. Do not select OK or Cancel yet.
- Now right-click on the extracted ProcessFinder.exe and select “Run As Administrator”.

- Select Check for | PSCAD.
- When the check is complete, go Actions | Same Messages As... Locate and send the saved messages file to our support desk (support@mhi.ca).

This file will tell us, and you, what processes or services are tripping up the PSCAD installer.

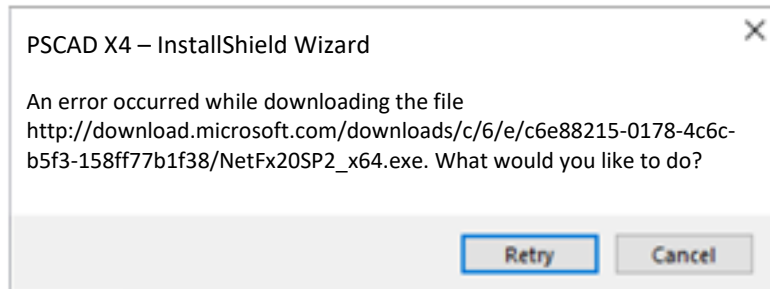
Solution 2-2 – Select the Option to Proceed

When the installation error message displays, select OK, and the installation should assume that the user has actually closed all instances of PSCAD, and the installation should proceed as normal, without actually checking again.

55. Receiving “An error occurred while downloading the file” Error Message

Problem

When attempting to install PSCAD, the installation fails, and the following error displays:



Cause

This error likely occurs for an older version of PSCAD, which would need older pre-requisite software. PSCAD is likely trying to download and install the older software (.NET Framework 2.0), but the older software is no longer available from the Microsoft website, and cannot be downloaded, and therefore the error displays.

Solution 1 – Update your PSCAD

Use a newer version of PSCAD, so that it does not call the older pre-requisite software for download.

Solution 2 – Obtain a Download for the Older Pre-Requisite Software

Obtain a download for the older pre-requisite software from a trusted source, then re-start the installation for the older PSCAD.

56. Receiving a “Microsoft Visual C++...is not installed” Error Message

Problem

When attempting to install Intel Fortran, the following message displays:



Cause

The redistributable software is not installed.

Solution 1 – Continue with the Installation

It is not expected that the missing redistributable will cause an issue when compiling PSCAD projects using this compiler. You should be able to ignore the message and continue with the installation.

Solution 2 – Install the Missing Pre-Requisite Software

Obtain a download for the older pre-requisite software [from a trusted source](#), then re-start the Intel Fortran compiler installation.

Downloads and instructions for installing PSCAD-related pre-requisite products and versions are available in this [article](#).

57. Even When De-selected, GFortran v8.1 is Installed

Problem

PSCAD and GFortran v8.1 are installed on a machine. The PSCAD installation package is run to initiate a PSCAD installation repair. During this installation, PSCAD is selected and GFortran v8.1 deselected. However, the installer does initiate the GFortran v8.1 installer.

Applicability

PSCAD v5.0.0 (initial) to PSCAD v5.0.0 Update 1

(Fixed in v5.0.0 Update 2)

Solution

Update your software to v5.0.0 Update 2.

58. The Intel oneAPI Installer Utility Window is Blank

Problem

When installing Intel Fortran oneAPI compiler for use with PSCAD projects, the installer utility displays no information, and is blank.

Cause

A graphics card that is incompatible with the Intel installer is installed on the machine.

Specifically, a customer experienced this issue when the following incompatible graphics card was installed on their machine:

Intel Core i7-3770 Processor, which integrates HD Intel 400 graphic card

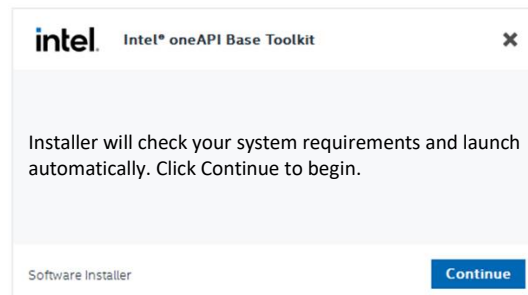
Solution

- Switch to a machine with a compatible graphics card, or
- Install a compatible graphics card, or. Refer to the Intel Release Notes for a compatible card.

59. When Installing Intel oneAPI, the Installation Ends Without Performing the Installation

Problem

When installing Intel Fortran oneAPI compiler (v19.2) for use with PSCAD projects, the installation seems to fail:



After selecting the “Continue” button in the above screen, the following screen displays momentarily, and then the installation appears to just end, unsuccessfully.



Possible Cause

If Microsoft® Visual Studio 2022 is already installed, this is somehow blocking the installation of Intel oneAPI.

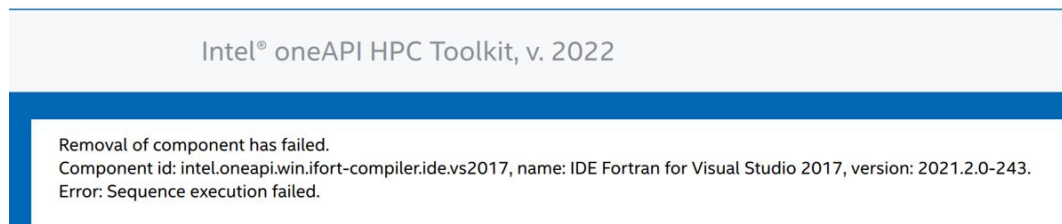

Problem

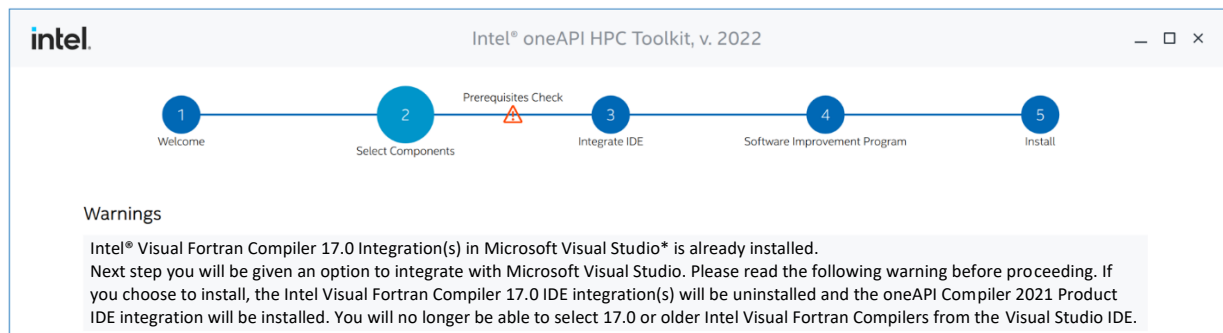

61. The Intel Installer Utility Shuts Down During the Installation

Problem

During the installation of Intel Fortran compiler, the user types in the license key in the Licensing page, the license appears to be successfully accepted, but then the Installer utility simply shuts down with not further messages.

Cause 1

Protection software is blocking the installation.

Solution 1

Somehow whitelist the installer.

Cause 2

A newer update of the same version is already installed, which is causing the installer to fail.

For example, Intel 15.5 is already installed, and the user is trying to install Intel 15.4.

Cause 1

The installer has detected that your license file is not already saved on the machine.

Solution 1

Ensure your Intel license file is saved to the location below, then relaunch the installation.

C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\Intel\Licenses

Cause 2

A newer update of the same version is already installed, which is causing the installer to fail.

For example, Intel 15.5 is already installed, and the user is trying to install Intel 15.4.

Solution 2

Uninstall and reinstall the software in the following order:

- Uninstall the newer update.
- Log out and log back in on your machine.
- Install the older update.
- Reinstall the newer update.

62. The InstallShield Wizard Shuts Down During the Installation of Visual C++ Redistributables

Problem

When the installer for PSCAD v4.6.3 is launched (InstallShield Wizard), and the user selects the option to install the Microsoft Visual C++ 2015 Update 3 Redistributable Package (x86), the Wizard installer simply shuts down.

Cause

Unknown

System

PSCAD v4.6.3

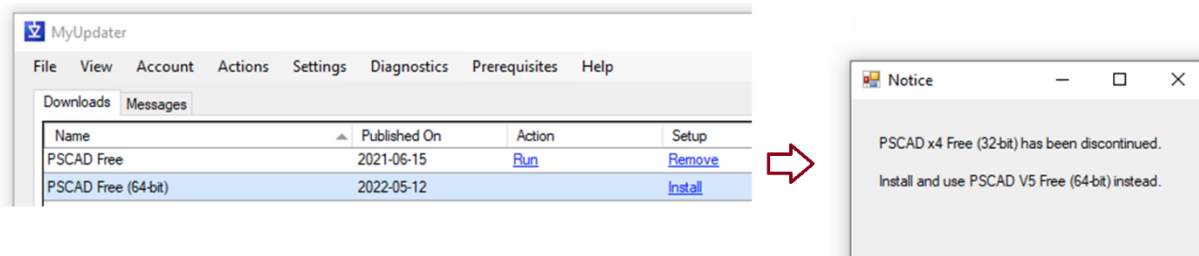
Solution

- Download the latest Fortran Medic utility, and use this to download and install either the Visual C++ 2019 or 2022 Redistributables.

63. Receiving a “PSCAD x4 Free (32-bit) has been discontinued” Error Message

Problem

When trying to install the PSCAD Free Edition (32-bit) via MyUpdater, after some time, the installation ends. Clicking on the “Run” button in the Action column displays the error as shown below:



Cause

The product, PSCAD v4.6.3 Free, 32-bit, has been discontinued.

Solution 1

If you need to use PSCAD v4.6.3, you will need to get access to a Professional or Educational license.

If your organization has any PSCAD licenses, please contact them.

If your organization does not have any PSCAD licenses, we would be pleased to provide some options (sales@pscad.com).

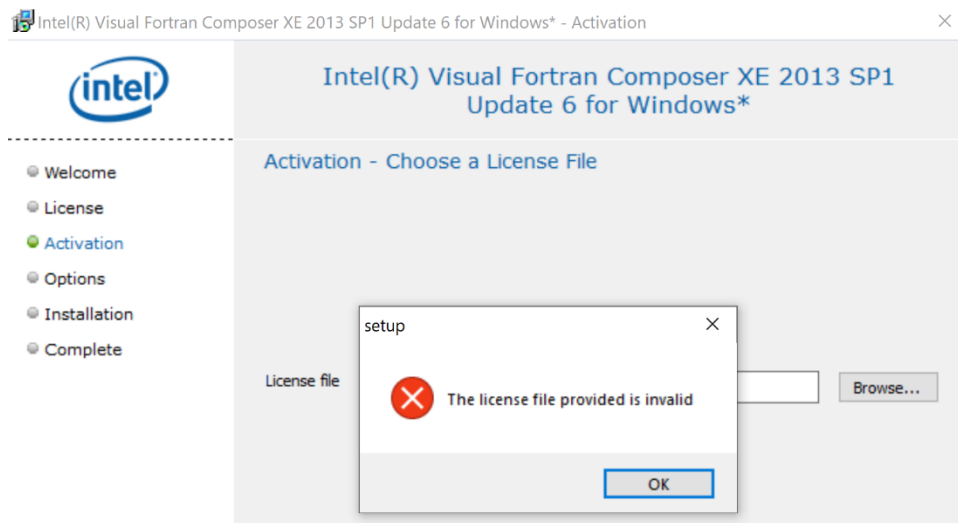
Solution 2

Use PSCAD V5 Free Edition instead. This software can be run from MyUpdater, “PSCAD Free (64-bit)”.

64. Receiving “The license file provided is invalid” Error Message

Problem

When trying to install Intel, using either the license’s associated license file or serial number (xxxx-xxxxxxx) on the Activate page results in the following error:



Cause

The customer has a valid license, and that license supports the version they are attempting to install. However, the associated license file and serial number (xxxx-xxxxxxx) being used in the Activation page are not supported in that version.

For example, the license for Intel oneAPI v19.2 supports Intel v14. However, the license file and serial number that are generated for Intel v19.2 are not supported in Intel v14.

Solution

Submit a support request to Intel, to request a different license file for your Intel v19.2 license, one that will be supported in Intel 14:

- Display the [Intel Online Service Center](#).
- Click *Request Support*, log in, and select only one of the following options to submit a support issue for Intel software development tools:
“Search for a product or service by name” or “Choose from a list”
- Once you are provided the associated license file, save the file to the following location as applicable (create any sub-folders as required), and retry the installation.

-64-bit Operating System:
C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\Intel\Licenses

-32-bit Operating System:
C:\Program Files\Common Files\Intel\Licenses

65. Receiving “5001 : 0x80070005” Error Message

Problem

When trying to install PSCAD, the installation fails, with the following error:

-5001 : 0x80070005

Cause

The user may not have sufficient permissions on their machine to perform the installation. Windows Administrator privileges are required, which include full permissions on the location of the program files (typically C:\Program files (x86)). Also required are full permissions for the registry as specified in Chart 3.1 of the requirements document posted to this [article](#).

Solution

Obtain sufficient permissions on your machine.

This [article](#) provides instructions for using the Fortran Medic utility to configure permissions on your machine.

66. Receiving the Error “Intel® oneAPI DPC++/C++ Compiler will not work because none of the supported environments is found on your computer” When Installing Intel oneAPI

Problem

When installing Intel Fortran oneAPI compiler (v19.2) for use with PSCAD projects, the installation seems to fail:

Warnings

Intel® oneAPI DPC++/C++ Compiler will not work because none of the supported environments is found on your computer

Intel® oneAPI DPC++/C++ Compiler requires that Microsoft Visual Studio® 2017, 2019 or 2022, or Microsoft Visual Studio Build Tools® 2017, 2019 or 2022 should be already installed and none was found on your computer. If you select 'Next', Intel® oneAPI DPC++/C++ Compiler will be installed but will not work. Please refer to Release Notes (<https://software.intel.com/content/www/us/en/develop/articles/intel-oneapi-dpc-c-compiler-release-notes.html>) for details.

Cause

Microsoft Visual Studio, required alongside Intel Fortran compiler for compiling PSCAD projects, is not detected as being installed. This product must be installed before installing the Intel Fortran compiler.

Solution

Install a supported version of Visual Studio, then restart your Intel Fortran compiler installation.

For information on obtaining a download, please contact the MHI support desk (support@mhi.ca). Ensure to include your PSCAD license number in your request.

67. The Intel Installer Crashes

Problem

When the Intel Installer is launched, the Installer crashes after displaying only one or two installer windows. No messages or errors indicating the cause are displayed.

Cause 1 – Intel 15 Update 4 Installer Fails Because it Detects A Newer, Previously or Currently, Installed Version of Intel 15

Specifically if launching Intel 15 Update 4, this issue has occurred if this Installer detects that a newer Intel 15 Update either is currently installed, or was previously installed then uninstalled. The newer updates are Intel 15 Update 5, Intel 15 Update 6 and Intel 15 Update 7

If the newer Update was previously installed then uninstalled, some remnants must remain from the installation, which are detected by the Update 4 Installer, causing the fail.

Solution 1-1 Switch to a Different Update

Try installing a different Intel 15 Update.

Solution 1-2 Switch to a Different Machine

Install Intel 15 Update 4 on a different machine, one that has not previously had any of the newer Updates installed.

Solution 1-3 Re-image Your Machine

If required to use Intel 15 Update 4 on the same machine, re-image your machine so that any remnants from the newer Update are removed, then install Intel 15 Update 4.

Cause 2 – Installers Other Than Intel 15 Update 4 Crash

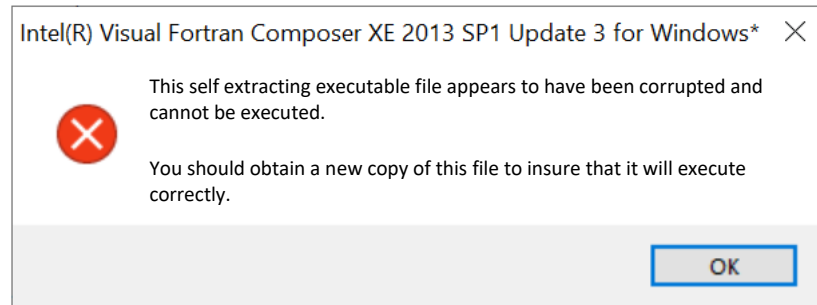
It is not currently known why the Intel compiler simply crashes when launching versions other than v15 Update 4.

Solution 2 – To Be Determined

68. Receiving the Error “This self extracting executable file appears to have been corrupted and cannot be executed...” When Installing an Intel Compiler

Problem

When installing an Intel Fortran compiler, the installation fails with an error similar to the following:



Cause

There is a problem with the installer.

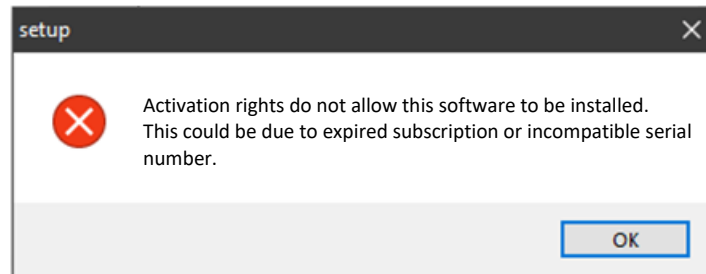
Solution

Obtain a different installer package.

69. Receiving the Error “Activation rights do not allow this software to be installed...”When Installing an Intel Compiler

Problem

When installing an Intel Fortran compiler, the installation fails with an error similar to the following:



Cause 1

This error can occur if the user entered an obsolete license number into the Intel Installer licensing page.

One example of an obsolete license number is due to a change that Intel performed to their named-user licenses in 2018, when Intel changed their from “System Locked” to “System Unlocked”. Existing license numbers were “retired”, and replaced with new license numbers.

Solution 1

Check whether your license number is still valid, or if it has been changed. This can be checked by entering your license number in this [page](#).

If the license number has been changed, then you can do either of the following:

- If the support on your license is active, you should be able to enter the new license number in the Intel Installer during the installation.
- If the support on your license is expired:
 - Request the license file from the [Intel User Forum](#).
 - Save the file to your machine:
64-bit Operating System: C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\Intel\Licenses
32-bit Operating System: C:\Program Files\Common Files\Intel\Licenses
 - Relaunch the installation.

Continued...

Cause 2

This error can occur if the support on your license is expired, and you are attempting to enter the license number in the Installer utility during the installation. When support is expired, you cannot enter the license number in the Installer utility, you must instead have the license file already installed on your machine, before launching the Installer.

Solution 2

- Request the license file from the [Intel User Forum](#).
- Save the file to your machine:
64-bit Operating System: C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\Intel\Licenses
32-bit Operating System: C:\Program Files\Common Files\Intel\Licenses
- Retry the installation.
